Captain's comments

President's comments

Treasurer's report

Handicap secretary's report

Secretary's report

Due to current fixture list October was mooted as a good month for this with the course being Birley GC. RK raised this at meeting to garner interest and all members present were keen on this to be looked into in more detail.

A suggestion was put forward to address possible odd numbers (as Birley society have a lot more members that us) is to mix the sides up via a draw before the actual day. Birley also said they would be willing to supply a trophy and possibly make it an annual event and have the presentation and make a night of it in the Birley after the golf. Due to feedback from members RK to take this forward and liaise with Birley society to get a date arranged.
