STEP 3: FOLD ON THE DASHED LINES! MAKE SURE YOU FOLD THEM COLOR SIDE DOWN!

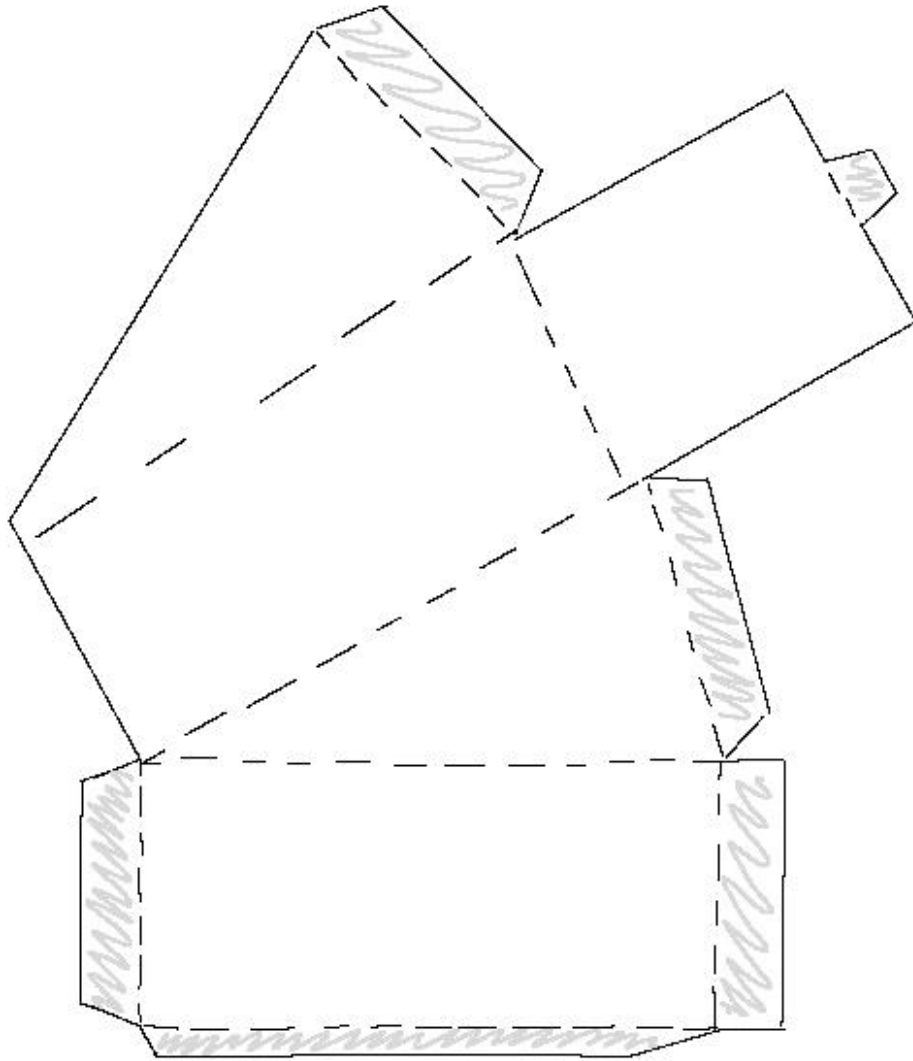


STEP FOUR: GLUE OR TAPE THE GREY REGIONS
