**This is an opportunity to demonstrate what you have learned in class,
throughout the semester and practice for your final oral examination.**

This presentation is worth 10% of your final grade.

EVALUATION CRITERIA	POINTS
The length of the presentation is a minimum of 4 minutes (.5 per minute).	/2
Student has a Power Point presentation with no spelling mistakes.	/1
Student speaks loudly enough to be heard by the whole class.	/1
Student demonstrates that they practiced and prepared by maintaining regular eye-contact with the audience throughout the presentation.	/1
Student focuses on producing the 'th' and 'L' sounds clearly.	/2
Student presents their topic clearly.	/1
Student demonstrates their overall improvement by including 2 words they have learned throughout the semester in this class (.5 per word).	/1
Student demonstrates their personal improvement by including 2 new words in their presentation (.5 per word).	/1
