

Final Oral Exam Evaluation Criteria
Introduction (5 points) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introduce yourself to your partner.
Pronunciation (15 points) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You will only be evaluated on words and sounds that were used in class throughout the semester; 1 point will be deducted per mispronounced word. • You must make your best attempt to produce the 'TH', 'W', 'V', 'L' sounds, as practiced in class; 1 point will be deducted per mispronounced word Note: You will not lose a point each time you mispronounce the same word.
Clarity (5 points) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You must speak loudly enough to be heard by your partner and the class. Tip: look at your partner while speaking, not the floor.
Quality of answer (15 points) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You must answer all questions in full sentences. • Your answers must be appropriate for the questions asked and must make sense. • You must hold a conversation that lasts at least 4 minutes; each student must both ask and answer a minimum of 1 question each.
