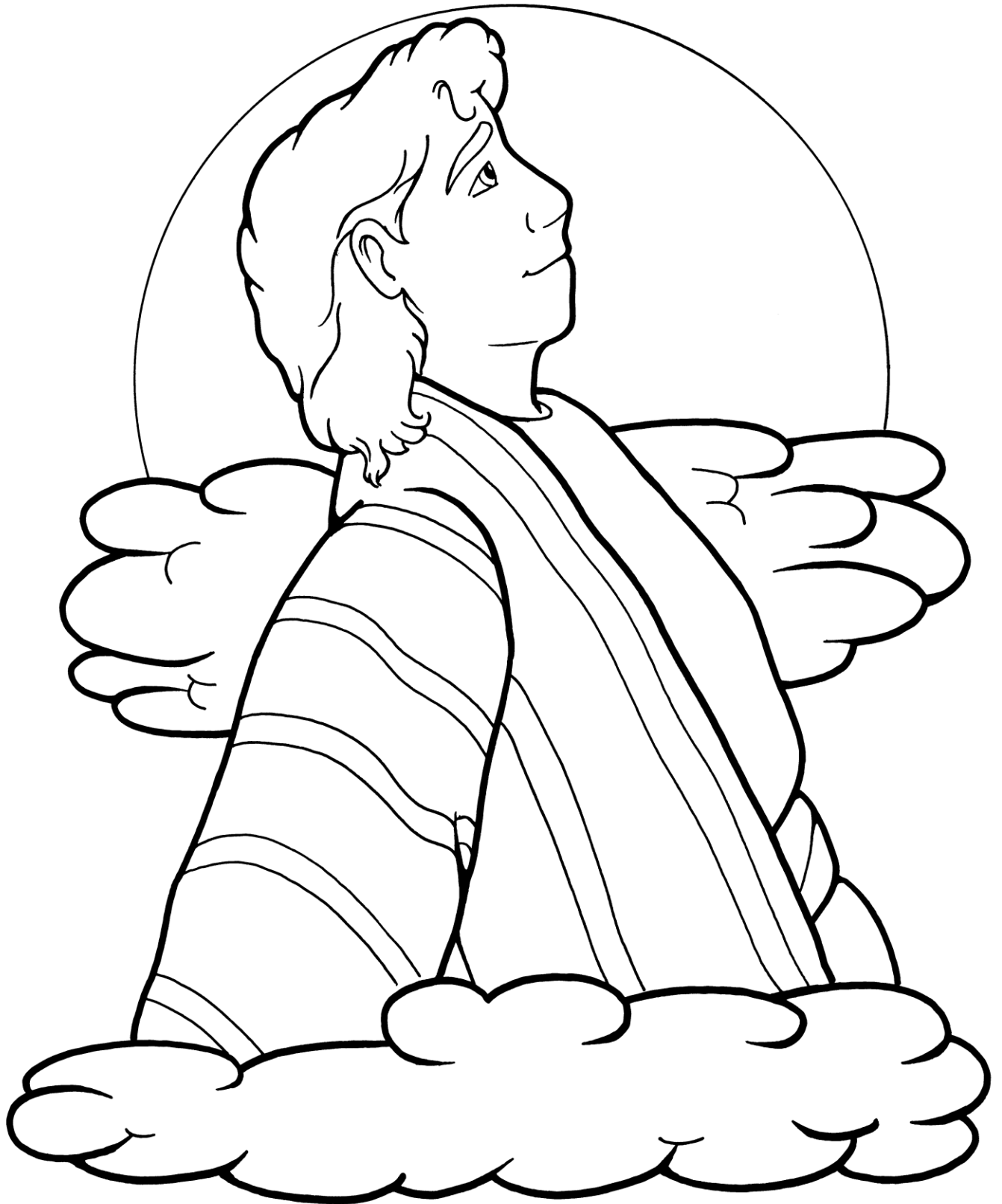


**Story Time - Read the story to the children**  
**Lesson 60: JOSHUA DIES**  
**JUDGES 2:7-10**

And the people of Israel were faithful to the Lord all the days that Joshua was their leader, and all the days of the responsible elders who were still alive after Joshua died, and had seen all the great works of the Lord which He had done for Israel. And then death came to Joshua, the son of Nun, the servant of the Lord, when he was a hundred and ten years old. And they put his body in the earth and buried him in the land of his inheritance in Timnath-heres, in the hill-country of Ephraim to the north of Mount Gaash. And after a while that whole generation of faithful men died; and another generation of people came after them, and they had no knowledge of the Lord or of the things which He had done for Israel.

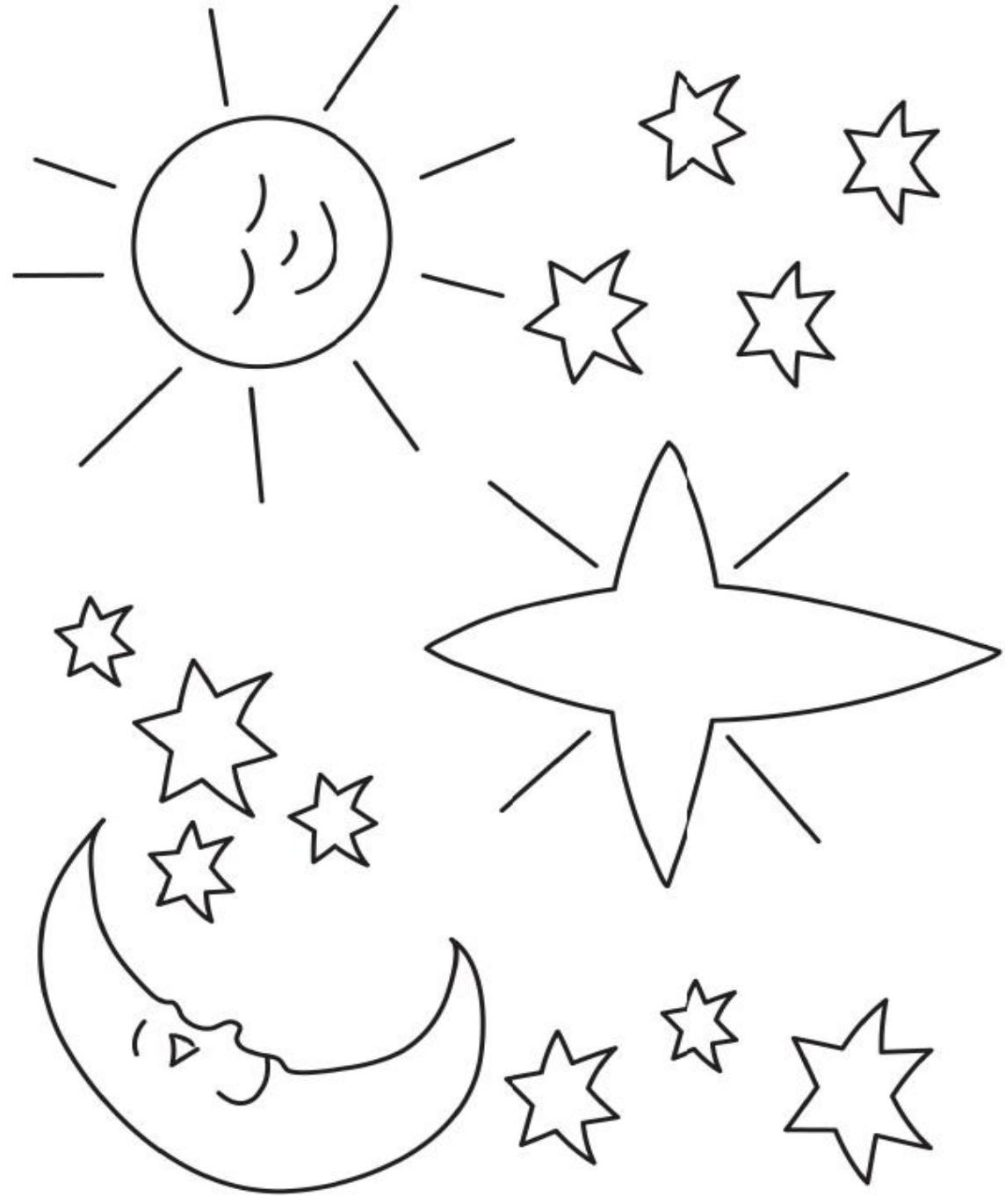
*"You have seen all that the LORD your God has done to all these nations because of you, for the LORD your God is He who has fought for you." JOSHUA 23:3*
