
Story Time - Read the story to the children Lesson 71: SAMUEL IS BORN 1 SAMUEL 1:20-28

Elkanah and his family went back home to Ramah. Later the LORD blessed Elkanah and Hannah with a son. She named him Samuel because she had asked the LORD for him. The next time Elkanah and his family went to offer their yearly sacrifice, he took along a gift that he had promised to give to the LORD. But Hannah stayed home, because she had told Elkanah, "Samuel and I won't go until he's old enough for me to stop nursing him. Then I'll give him to the LORD, and he can stay there at Shiloh for the rest of his life."

"You know what's best," Elkanah said. "Stay here until it's time to stop nursing him. I'm sure the LORD will help you do what you have promised." Hannah did not go to Shiloh until she stopped nursing Samuel. When it was the time of year to go to Shiloh again, Hannah and Elkanah took Samuel to the LORD's house. They brought along a three-year-old bull, a twenty-pound sack of flour, and a clay jar full of wine. Hannah and Elkanah offered the bull as a sacrifice, then brought the little boy to Eli. "Sir," Hannah said, "a few years ago I stood here beside you and asked the LORD to give me a child. Here he is! The LORD gave me just what I asked for. Now I am giving him to the LORD, and he will be the LORD's servant for as long as he lives."


TRUE OR FALSE

Put all questions and answers on separate pieces of paper; put questions in one jar or paper cup and answers in another jar or paper cup. Let one child pick and read a question and another child pick an answer (younger children, have a child pick the question and you read it, same with the answer). The answers in this game will not always fit the questions; in contrast, God's answers always fit exactly. In today's lesson, we saw how God answered the prayer of a godly woman named Hannah.
