
Story Time - Read the story to the children Lesson 130: HAMAN'S ANGER AT MORDECAI ESTHER 5:1-14

Esther and her women servants, and Mordecai and all the Jews in Susa had been fasting and praying for three days. On the third day, Esther put on her special robes. Then she stood in the inside area of the king's palace, in front of the king's hall. The king was sitting on his throne in the hall, facing the place where people enter the throne room. When the king saw Queen Esther standing in the court, he was very pleased. He held out to her the gold scepter that was in his hand. So Esther went in to the room and went near the king. Then she touched the end of the king's gold scepter. Then the king asked, "What is bothering you Queen Esther? What do you want to ask me? I will give you anything you ask for, even half my kingdom." Esther said, "I have prepared a party for you and Haman. Will you and Haman please come to the party today?" Then the king said, "Bring Haman quickly so that we may do what Esther asks." So the king and Haman went to the party Esther had prepared for them. While they were drinking wine, the king asked her again, "Now Esther, what do you want to ask for? Ask for anything, I will give it to you. So what is it you want? I will give you anything you want, up to half my kingdom." Esther answered, "This is what I want to ask for: If the king is pleased with me and thinks it is good to give me what I ask for, let the king and Haman come tomorrow. I will prepare another party for them. Then I will tell what I really want." Haman left the king's palace that day very happy and in a good mood. Lesson 130 Activity Make Your Own Scepter!

Materials:

Paper towel tubes (or you can tape together three toilet paper tubes with masking tape) Scotch Tape Glue (bottle & glue sticks) Glitter, Stickers, Sequins Crayons, Markers Construction Paper

Instructions

Print out the scepter top patterns.


Cut the scepter top patterns out

Trace the patterns onto either construction paper or card stock paper – trace as many as you can on a piece of construction or card stock paper – you will need two for each child's scepter.

Cut out the scepter tops and set aside. (older children can cut their own, but it may just be best to cut them yourself)

Give the children each two of the same scepter top and a piece of construction paper (or card stock paper) and have them decorate, color, glue glitter on, put stickers on, etc. TELL THEM TO LEAVE A COUPLE OF INCHES ON ONE SIDE (long-ways) BLANK – this will be overlapped and their decorations will just be ruined & not seen on that couple of inches.

Take the construction or card stock paper and tape it around the tube (long-ways), with the blank edge underneath. You can try using a glue stick instead of tape – you may have to tape it first until the glue dries. Glue the scepter tops (one on each side) onto the top of the scepters!



(Be sure to leave a couple inches blank on the side of the paper!

PRAYER Lead the children in a prayer of commitment to guard their hearts against bitterness, anger, and hatred and to be ready to forgive when they are wronged just as Christ forgave them. If there are any children who have not yet responded to the Gospel, give them opportunity.

Top to Scepters
