Story Time - Read the story to the children Lesson 146: NEW HEAVENS AND A NEW EARTH ISAIAH 65:17-25

For see, I am making a new heaven and a new earth: and the past things will be gone completely out of mind. But men will be glad and have joy forever in what I am making; for I am making Jerusalem a delight, and her people a joy. And I will be glad over Jerusalem, and have joy in my people: and the voice of weeping and crying will no longer be heard in Jerusalem, or the voice of grief. No longer will there be there a child dies at a young age, or an old man who doesn't live a long time: for the young man will be a hundred years old when he dies, and whoever's life is shorter than one hundred years will seem as if they are cursed. And they will be building houses and living in them; planting vine-gardens and getting the fruit of them. They will no longer be building for other people to live in them, or planting for others to have the fruit: for the my people will live to be as old as trees, and my loved ones will have a lot of joy in the work of their hands. Their work will not be for nothing, and they will not give birth to children just so they can die; for they are a seed that the Lord has given His blessing to, and their children will be with them. And before they finish saying their prayer I will answer them, and while they are still saying their prayer to me, I will hear. The wolf and the lamb will eat together, and the lion will make a meal of grass just like the ox: but dust will be the snake's food. There will be no cause of pain or destruction in all my holy mountain, says the Lord.

Lesson 146 Craft


Heavenly Mansion
