Story Time - Read the story to the children Lesson 165: GABRIEL VISITS MARY LUKE 1:26-28

One month later God sent the angel Gabriel to the town of Nazareth in Galilee with a message for a virgin named Mary. She was engaged to Joseph from the family of King David. The angel greeted Mary and said, "You are truly blessed! The Lord is with you."




Activity Idea

Supply List; Index card or other sturdy paper Scissors

Show the children the card, and ask them if they think you could cut a hole in it large enough that one of them could step through it. After they decide that it would be impossible, begin to cut the paper. (See illustration. Cut on narrow lines. You might want to practice on an extra sheet of paper before class.) Fold paper in half longways, and cut slits across paper. Unfold the paper and cut down the center, avoiding both ends. Open the paper, pulling it into a very large circle. Have the kids walk through the hole in the paper. "Sometimes things seem impossible for us, just like that seemed impossible to you. For God though, nothing is impossible. He can do anything. For Zacharias and Elizabeth, he gave them a child when that seemed impossible."




How to Fit Your Body Through an Index Card Step-by-Step Photos



From Step 2

Cut a slit on each side near the left and right edges. The slits should be vertical and go down from the fold, NOT from the unfolded edges. Do not cut the ends; leave a bit of space.


How to Fit Your Body Through an Index Card Step-by-Step Photos



From Step 3

Snip off the folded edge. Be careful to not cut the ends, and stop when you reach the slits.

How to Fit Your Body Through an Index Card



From Step 4

Make more cuts with the scissors. Alternate each cut, one coming from the unfolded edge and then one coming from the folded edge. They should all be parallel to one another.

Now, gently open into a large circle that is large enough for the children to step through!
