

Story Time - Read the story to the children
Lesson 234: JUDAS BETRAYS JESUS
LUKE 22:47-53

(Last week's lesson included the following, so tell the children you are re-reading this portion for this week if they complain that they've already done this lesson!)

While Jesus was speaking, a crowd came up. It was led by Judas, one of the twelve apostles. He came over to Jesus to kiss him. But Jesus said to him, "Judas, are you betraying (meaning are you delivering me to my enemies) the Son of Man with a kiss?" The followers of Jesus were standing there too. They saw what was happening and said to Jesus, "Lord, should we use our swords?" And one of them did use his sword. He cut off the right ear of the servant of the high priest. Jesus said, "Let it go - stop!" Then he touched the servant's ear and healed him. Jesus spoke to the group that came to arrest him. They were the leading priests, the older Jewish leaders, and the Jewish soldiers. He said to them, "Have you come out to catch a robber with swords and clubs? I was with you every day in the Temple area. Why didn't you try to arrest me there? But this is your time--the time when darkness rules."
