- Work package 3, entitled "Improving the scientific content" was presented and explained by the WP3 Leaders: Eustachio Tarasco and Aleksandra Ignjatović Ćupina. Aleksandra Ignjatović Ćupina gave the presentation about WP3 structure, objectives, tasks, outcomes and activities. > In continuation of the workshop, the creation of working subgroups related to particular scientific disciplines within Plant Health in Sustainable Agriculture was discussed.

Regarding the composition of the subgroup 7, and taking in account the particular importance of subgroup 7 contents in developing and widening the general contents of transversal interest and skills of PhD students in scientific research, it was decided that each partner institution should delegate at least one expert representative. Taking in account the required personal experience and expertise, some of the appointed members in the subgroup 7 were recruited from other WPs within the project teams.

The structure of each working subgroup according the regarded aspects (number of teachers and their titles, number of students, number of countries and PIs involved, and gender issue) are summarized, as given below:

- 1. Diagnosis in plant health and IPM (5 teachers: 1 Professor, 3 Associate Professors, 1 Assistant Professor + 1 student; 5 countries; 5 partner institutions; 4 males + 2 females)
- 2. Sustainable use of pesticides (6 teachers: 1 Professor, 4 Associate Professors, 1 Assistant Professor + 5 students; 7 countries; 8 Pls; 7 males + 4 females)
- 3. Plant feeders (7 teachers: 2 Professors, 2 Associate Professors, 3 Assistant Professors + 4 students; 6 countries; 8 Pls; 1 male + 10 females)
- 4. Plant Pathology (6 teachers: 1 Professor, 3 Associate Professors, 2 Assistant Professors + 9 students; 8 countries; 10 Pls; 5 males + 10 females)
- 5. Weed science (8 teachers: 3 Professors, 4 Associate Professors, 1 Assistant Professor + 4 students; 5 countries; 8 Pls; 6 males + 6 females)
- 6. Mycotoxins and food safety (6 teachers: 1 Professor, 4 Associate Professors, 1 Assistant Professor + 2 students: 6 countries: 6 Pls: 5 males + 3 females)
