WHAT IS CYBERBULLYING?

- It's *bullying* what takes place over *digital devices* like cell phones, computers, and tablets.

The most common places where cyberbullying occurs are:

- *Social Media*, such as Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, and Twitter
- *SMS* (Short Message Service)
- *Instant Message*
- *Email*
