

Your guide to managing your pet's anxiety



Nervousness or anxiety?

Anxiety and nervous behaviour in dogs and cats can be due to a number of varied causes, from fear of a specific situation such as travelling, going into kennels or a visit to the vets to a habitual ingrained anxiety. Herbal products are ideal to induce a calm and relaxed demeanour, but some cases will also benefit from the use of behavioural techniques from a qualified animal behaviourist.

- · Plan ahead for situations which may be fearful
- Make a plan of action to address the problem and try to stick to it!
- Install confidence and security through positive and consistent behaviour
- Consult a qualified professional for behavioural/training advice if needed


Habitual anxiety or nervousness

This may have various causes but with longer term use of our herbal medicines and behavioural techniques, improvement can be achieved with time. Rescued or re-homed dogs may have issues from their previous life and can take some time to adjust and so often benefit from our herbal products as they learn to adapt.

Age related stress

In old age some dogs can suffer from anxiety that may be due to deterioration of sensory function associated with age, and the feeling of loss of role and function may develop. This may result in disorientation, random barking, inability to settle and general restlessness.

Fear of specific situations

Specific situations such as thunderstorms, travelling, showing, going into kennels or to the vets can cause anxiety. Often the problem is not really nervousness but fear or apprehension of what is expected when a new situation or experience arises. This is often the case with young dogs, but with correct training and the appropriate herbal treatment can be overcome as they mature.



Organic Valerian Compound

For anxiety in specific "one off" or unexpected situations this liquid, containing three herbal extracts, will work quickly to relax and settle dogs within half an hour of administration. Putting a few drops on the bedding helps to induce a calm state by giving off an aroma which cats in particular find reassuring. May be used in addition to Scullcap & Valerian Tablets in particularly stressful situations.
