Introduction

The following pages list data for all known family members as of July 7, 2019.

Each immediate family is presented in their own section that contains a graphical family tree as well as a description with information about each referenced person and their children. The child section provides information about the children of the preceding couple. When a child has offspring of their own this is presented in a separate family section for that child. In this case a '+' is used to denote that an individual will appear later in the book as a parent with his/her own children and there is a link to the appropriate family reference number. For children with partners but no offspring the partner data is given with the reference family. Roman numerals, followed by a period, are used to indicate the birth order.

In the chapter titled "Family of the Starting Person" the ancestors of Drucilla Durden and Asa Haley are presented in a kind of enhanced Pedigree Chart which displays the graphic representation of their direct-line ancestors and the children of the couple. This chapter contains information about the couple whose offspring are listed in the later chapters.

The chapter titled "Families of her Descendants" provides details (as known as of the publication date) for the offspring of Drucilla Durden and Asa Haley. There is a chapter for each generation. Relatives are listed in the order of the nearness of their relationship.

This document reports the details of 31 individuals, of whom 15 are male and 16 are female. Of the 15 individuals with recorded birth and death dates, the average lifespan was 61.07 years. Of these, 9 males averaged 56.56 years, and 6 females averaged 67.83 years. The longest living male was Ed Green Haley (1892–1979), who died aged 87. The longest living female was Roberta LNU (1901–1996), who died aged 95.

She was also counted in the census on June 19, 1900, in Bossier, Louisiana, USA (as Druscilla Haley the 28 year old wife and mother of 8 children [5 living]). Later Drucilla appeared in the census in Bossier, Louisiana, USA, on June 19, 1900 (as Druscilla Haley the 28 year old wife and mother of 8 children [5 living]). She was recorded on May 11, 1910, in the census (as Silla Hailey, the 38 year old farm laborer, wife and mother of 7 children on Nickelson Plantation). Drucilla was also counted in the census on May 11, 1910 (as Silla Hailey, the 38 year old farm laborer, wife and mother of 7 children on Nickelson Plantation). Later she appeared in the census in Police Jury Ward 1, Bossier, Louisiana, USA, on January 20, 1920 (as the 49 year old wife and mother of 2 children). Drucilla was recorded in Police Jury Ward 1, Bossier, Louisiana, USA, on January 20, 1920, in the census (as the 49 year old wife and mother of 2 children). She was also counted in the census on April 25, 1930, in Police Jury Ward 2, Bossier, Louisiana, USA (as the 56 year old wife and grandmother). Later Drucilla appeared in the census in Police Jury Ward 2, Bossier, Louisiana, USA, on April 25, 1930 (as the 56 year old wife and grandmother).

She died in Louisiana, USA.

At the age of 15, Drucilla married **Asa Haley** on Saturday, April 9, 1887, in Caddo, Louisiana, USA, when he was 22 years old. They had seven sons: Ardis (1888–), Ed (1892–1979), George (1893–1920), William (1894–), Euestis (1899–1979), Lee (ca.1904–) and Dewitt (ca.1906–1933).

Asa Haley was born in Greenwood, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on Friday, December 23, 1864. He was the son of Anderson Haley and Lucy Harris.

Asa was recorded in Police Jury Ward 2, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on June 23, 1870, in the census (as the 4-year-old son of Anderson and Lucy Hayley). He was also counted in the census in June 1880 in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA (as the 13-year-old farm laborer and son). Later Asa appeared in the census in Police Jury Ward 6, Bossier, Louisiana, USA, on June 19, 1900 (as the 36-year-old farmer and head of household). He was recorded on May 11, 1910, in the census (as the 44-year-old farmer and head of household). Asa was also counted in the census on January 20, 1920, in Police Jury Ward 1, Bossier, Louisiana, USA (as the 54-year-old farmer and head of household). Later he appeared in the census in Police Jury Ward 2, Bossier, Louisiana, USA, on April 25, 1930 (as the 65-year-old cotton farmer and head of household).

Asa reached 66 years of age and died in Greenwood, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on September 10, 1931.
