

Introduction

The following pages list data for all known family members as of July 7, 2019.

Each immediate family is presented in their own section that contains a graphical family tree as well as a description with information about each referenced person and their children. The child section provides information about the children of the preceding couple. When a child has offspring of their own this is presented in a separate family section for that child. In this case a '+' is used to denote that an individual will appear later in the book as a parent with his/her own children and there is a link to the appropriate family reference number. For children with partners but no offspring the partner data is given with the reference family. Roman numerals, followed by a period, are used to indicate the birth order.


In the chapter titled "Family of the Starting Person" the ancestors of Margaret Durden and Ed Harris are presented in a kind of enhanced Pedigree Chart which displays the graphic representation of their direct-line ancestors and the children of the couple. This chapter contains information about the couple whose offspring are listed in the later chapters.

The chapter titled "Families of her Descendants" provides details (as known as of the publication date) for the offspring of Margaret Durden and Ed Harris. There is a chapter for each generation. Relatives are listed in the order of the nearness of their relationship.

This document reports the details of 15 individuals, of whom 8 are male and 7 are female. Of the 9 individuals with recorded birth and death dates, the average lifespan was 74.56 years. Of these, 5 males averaged 70.6 years, and 4 females averaged 79.5 years. The longest living male was Cleveland Washington (1917–2016), who died aged 98. The longest living female was Luella Harris (1893–1985), who died aged 91.

1. **Margaret^o Durden** was born in January 1872 in Greenwood, Caddo, Louisiana, USA. She was the daughter of Maltimore Durden and Paralee Glover.

Margaret was recorded in Bossier, Louisiana, USA, in June 1880 in the census (as the 6 year old daughter of Paralee and Maltimore Durden). She was also counted in the census on June 18, 1900, in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA (as the 28 year old wife, farm laborer and mother of 5 children). Later Margaret appeared in the census in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on June 18, 1900 (as the 28 year old wife, farm laborer and mother of 5 children). She was recorded in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on April 28, 1910, in the census (as the 30 year old wife, farm laborer and mother of 6 children [3 living at home]). Margaret was also counted in the census on April 28, 1910, in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA (as the 30 year old wife, farm laborer and mother of 6 children [3 living at home]). Later she appeared in the census in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on January 31, 1920 (as the 50 year old wife). Margaret was recorded in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on January 31, 1920, in the census (as the 50 year old wife). She was also counted in the census on April 15, 1930, in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA (as the 53 year old wife on Spring Ridge Rd). Later Margaret appeared in the census in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on April 15, 1930 (as the 53 year old wife on Spring Ridge Rd).

She died in Greenwood, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on April 18, 1954, at the age of 82.

Margaret married **Ed Harris** on Sunday, November 16, 1890, in Caddo, Louisiana, USA. They had five children: Ida (1892-), Luella (1893-1985), Minnie (1896-), Maggie (1898-) and Dan (1900-).

Ed Harris was born in Louisiana, USA, in May 1872. He was the son of David Harris.

Ed was recorded in Police Jury Ward 3, Lincoln, Louisiana, USA, on June 10, 1880, in the census (as the 8 year old son). He was also counted in the census on June 10, 1880, in Police Jury Ward 3, Lincoln, Louisiana, USA (as the 8 year old son). Later Ed appeared in the census in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on June 18, 1900 (as the 28 year old farmer and head of household). He was recorded in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on April 28, 1910, in the census (as the 36 year old farmer and head of

household). Ed was also counted in the census on April 28, 1910, in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA (as the 36 year old farmer and head of household). Later he appeared in the census in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on January 31, 1920 (as the 50 year old farmer and head of household). Ed was recorded in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on January 31, 1920, in the census (as the 50 year old farmer and head of household). He was also counted in the census on April 15, 1930, in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA (as the 57 year old farmer and head of household on Spring Ridge Rd). Later Ed appeared in the census in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on April 15, 1930 (as the 57 year old farmer and head of household on Spring Ridge Rd).

Ed reached 74 years of age and died in Greenwood, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on November 24, 1946.




Figure 1: Margaret Durden Harris - Headstone



Ida was recorded in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on June 18, 1900, in the census (as the 8 year old daughter). She was also counted in the census on April 28, 1910, in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA (as the 18 year old farm laborer and daughter).

She married **FNU Thompson**. They have no known children.

He is also known as **Husband of Ida Harris**.

3. **Luella¹ Harris** (*Margaret⁰ Durden*) was born on Saturday, July 1, 1893, in Greenwood, Caddo, Louisiana, USA. She was the daughter of Ed Harris and Margaret Durden (1).

Luella was recorded in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on June 18, 1900, in the census (as the 6 year old daughter). She was also counted in the census on June 18, 1900, in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA (as the 6 year old daughter). Later Luella appeared in the census in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on April 28, 1910 (as the 16 year old daughter and farm laborer). She was recorded in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on April 28, 1910, in the census (as the 16 year old daughter and farm laborer). Luella was also counted in the census on January 31, 1920, in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA (as the 25 year old single daughter). Later she appeared in the census in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on April 17, 1930 (as the 30 year old wife, farm laborer and mother of 1 child). Luella was recorded in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on April 17, 1930, in the census (as the 30 year old wife, farm laborer and mother of 1 child). She was also counted in the census on April 19, 1940, in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA (as the 38 year old wife and mother of 1 child).

Luella died in Shreveport, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, in April 1985 at the age of 91.

She married **T C Lewis**. They had one daughter: Marty (1928-).

T C Lewis was born in Greenwood, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on Sunday, September 13, 1891. He was the son of Edward W Lewis and Georgia Jeter.


T C was recorded in Police Jury Ward 6, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on June 9, 1900, in the census (as the 8 year old son). He was also counted in the census on April 20, 1910, in Police Jury Ward 6, Caddo, Louisiana, USA (as the 14 year old son and farm laborer on Spring Ridge & Greenwood Road). Later T C appeared in the census in Police Jury Ward 6, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, in 1920. He was recorded in Caddo, Louisiana, USA, in 1930 in the census. T C was also counted in the census on April 1, 1940, in Caddo, Louisiana, USA.

T C reached 74 years of age and died in Greenwood, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, in July 1966.

Minnie was recorded in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on June 18, 1900, in the census (as Rittie, the 3-year-old daughter). She was also counted in the census on June 18, 1900, in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA (as Rittie, the 3-year-old daughter). Later Minnie appeared in the census in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on April 28, 1910 (as the 14 year old farm laborer and daughter). She was recorded in Police Jury Ward 2, Madison, Louisiana, USA, on April 2, 1920, in the census (as the 19 year old wife and mother of 1 child).

Minnie married **Bennie Washington** in Greenwood, Caddo, Louisiana, USA. They had three children: Cleveland (1917–2016), W (ca.1918–) and Leberta (1919–).


Bennie Washington was born in Greenwood, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on Wednesday, January 6, 1897. He was the son of George Washington and Josephine Lewis. He was also known as **Bennie Washington**.

Bennie was recorded in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on June 18, 1900, in the census (as the 2-year-old son). He was also counted in the census on April 20, 1910, in Police Jury Ward 6, Caddo, Louisiana, USA (as the 12 year old son on Spring Ridge and Greenwood Rds.). Later Bennie appeared in the census in Police Jury Ward 2, Madison, Louisiana, USA, on April 6, 1920 (as the 22 year old farm laborer and head of household).

Bennie reached 63 years of age and died in Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on May 25, 1960.

Cleveland worked as a Porter. He was recorded in St Landry, Louisiana, USA, in 1920 in the census (Marital Status: Single Relation to Head of House: Son). Cleveland was also counted in the census on April 8, 1940, in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA (as the 23 year old farmer and head of household).

He served in the military in Shreveport, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on October 22, 1943 (Enlistment). Cleveland died at passed away at home at approximately 11:30 am. in Greenwood, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on February 9, 2016, at the age of 98. His funeral was held at Winnfield Funeral Home in Shreveport, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on February 20, 2016. Cleveland was buried at Mount Olive Missionary Baptist Church Cemetery in Shreveport, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on February 20, 2016.

Cleveland married **Frankie Mae Okra** in Greenwood, Caddo, Louisiana, USA. They had eight children: David (ca.1930-2012), Willie (1935-2009), Eugene (1937-), Lou (ca.1938-), Mabel (1941-), Leon (1947-), Eddie (1948-) and Irene (1951-).

Frankie Mae Okra was born in Greenwood, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on Monday, September 8, 1919. She was the daughter of Johnson Okra and Nancy Murray.






