

Introduction

The following pages list data for all known immediate family members as of June 20, 2019.

Each immediate family is presented in their own section that contains a graphical family tree as well as a description with information about each referenced person and their children. The child section provides information about the children of the preceding couple. When a child has offspring of their own this is presented in a separate family section for that child. In this case a '+' is used to denote that an individual will appear later in the book as a parent with his/her own children and there is a link to the appropriate family reference number. For children with partners but no offspring the partner data is given with the reference family. Roman numerals, followed by a period, are used to indicate the birth order.

In the chapter titled "Families of the Starting Person" the ancestors of Maltimore Durden are presented in a kind of enhanced Pedigree Chart which displays the graphic representation of their direct-line ancestors and the children of the couple. This chapter contains information about the couple whose offspring are listed in the later chapters.

The chapter titled "Families of the Descendants" provides details (as known as of the publication date) for the offspring of Maltimore Durden ((children and grandchildren). There is a chapter for each generation. Relatives are listed in the order of the nearness of their relationship.

This document reports the details of 16 families) that include 43 individuals, of whom 23 are male and 20 are female. Of the 25 individuals with recorded birth and death dates, the average lifespan was 71.04 years. Of these, 10 males averaged 72.8 years, and 15 females averaged 69.87 years. The longest living male was Alfred Aaron (1865–1957), who died aged 92. The longest living female was Ophelia Durden (1892–1982), who died aged 89.



Maltimore was recorded in Bossier, Louisiana, USA, on June 8, 1880, in the census (as the 35 year old married laborer and head of household). He was also counted in the census on June 8, 1900, in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA (as the 54 year old farmer and head of household). Later Maltimore appeared in the census in Greenwood, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on April 22, 1910 (65 year old married farmer and head of household on Spring Ridge Rd).

He died in Greenwood, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, between 1911 and 1920.



Maltimore Durden married **Paralee Glover** in 1870 in Caddo, Louisiana, USA. They had eight children: William (1869–), Drucilla (1871–), Margaret (1872–1954), Rachel (1875–), Mahala (1879–1944), Irene (1883–1959), Mizie (1884–1971) and Elijah (1895–1914).

Paralee Glover was born in Virginia, USA, in January 1841. She was the daughter of Drucilla Davis. She was also known as **Paralee Durden**.

Paralee was recorded in Bossier, Louisiana, USA, on June 8, 1880, in the census (as the 36 yr. old wife and mother of 5 children). She was also counted in the census on June 8, 1900, in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA (as Paralee Dunbey, the 59 year old wife and mother of 9 children [8 living]). Later Paralee appeared in the census in Police Jury Ward 5, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on April 22, 1910 (as the 69 year old wife on Spring Ridge Rd farm).

Paralee reached 78 years of age and died in Greenwood, Caddo, Louisiana, USA, about 1919.



He was also counted in the census on June 8, 1880, in Bossier, Louisiana, USA (as the 11 year old son of Paralee and Maltimore Durden). Later William appeared in the census in Springhill, Hempstead, Arkansas, USA, on July 7, 1900 (as the 30 year old married farmer and head of household).


He died in Louisiana, USA.

She died in Louisiana, USA.



Tom reached 52 years of age and died in Caddo, Louisiana, USA, on November 29, 1925.



Later Irene appeared in the census in Justice Precinct 6, Wilbarger, Texas, USA, on April 22, 1930 (as Arena Ephriam, the 44 year old wife and mother of 4 children on St James Road). She was recorded in Justice Precinct 6, Wilbarger, Texas, USA, on April 22, 1930, in the census (as the 44 year old wife and mother of 4 children on St James Road). Irene lived in 1959 in Dallas, Dallas, Texas, USA (4528 Helen St.).

Characterized by easy bruising, feeling fatigue, pain or fullness below your ribs on the left side.
