procedural writing	This is text that writes about a procedure or giving instructions.
adverb	A word that modifies or adds to an adjective, verb, or another adverb.
adjective	A word that adds to or describes a noun.
instructions	Detailed information telling how something should be done.

simple sentence	A sentence containing one verb.
