












### Population movements

### Environmental pressures

-  High density of refugee population
-  Population density higher than 200 hab. per km<sup>2</sup>
-  Protected areas (natural parcs and reserves)
-  Deforestation or illegal logging
-  Marshlands
-  Zone under threat of drying due to excess withdrawal and use of water (irrigation and electricity production)
