In an effort to bring advanced STEAM opportunities to local school systems, JSU, with the support of the Alabama State Department of Education, will be providing scholarship opportunities for TWO STEAM-based dual enrollment courses at the JSU McClellan location for Fall 2019.

- Students must meet the academic criteria for dual enrollment: 3.0+ High School GPA
- Class size is set at 20 students per class
- Applications are reviewed by a committee

- Pre-requisites apply for MS125 Student should have completed MS113 as Dual Enrollment or AP Calculus, and should complete the EdReady Math Placement achieving Benchmark Score of 100
- Class attendance policy will follow the departmental guidelines, not the high school guidelines
- Students completing one or both courses in the program will be recognized at senior awards' ceremonies by the JSU Admissions Office
- Computer lab access guaranteed
- Textbooks are included with scholarship
- Transportation to and from JSU McClellan is **NOT** included
