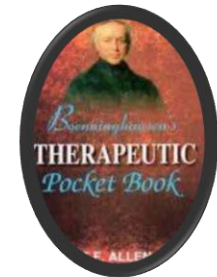

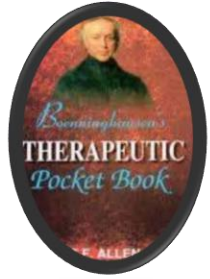

Why he gave so few mental s/m???

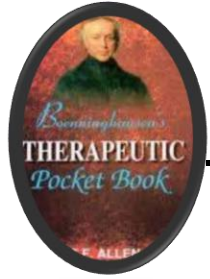
— his work on the concept of the whole man

- value on concomitants and the modalities
- not his intention to reflect the whole man through his mental reactions, as they may be difficult to get
- Importance to four-square foundation





- Boenninghausen has followed Hahnemann's principle that **Emotional cause is responsible** for disturbed function in establishing equilibrium
- So **Aggravation** chapters include **17** rubrics
 - **Excitement, emotional**



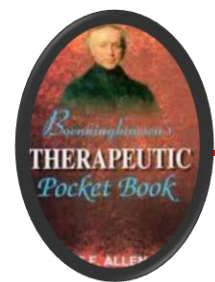
— First rubric “Disposition generally affected” include medicines which affect the mind in general.

— Absence of mind

- KENT – MIND - ABSENTMINDED
- BBCR - MIND - Absence of mind, lost in thoughts, absent minded

— Alternating moods

- KENT – MOOD, Alternating
- BBCR - MIND - Variable, vacillating and alternating moods

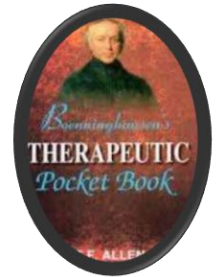


– **Amativeness** = inclined towards love, especially sexual

- KENT – MIND, AMOROUS (CR: LASCIVIOUSNESS)
 - MIND - LASCIVIOUSNESS, lustful
 - MIND - LEWDNESS
- BBCR - MIND - AMOROUS, AMATIVE, LASCIVIOUS, LEWD

– **Avarice** = greedy, miserly

- KENT – MIND, MISERLY (CR: AVARICE)
 - MIND – AVARICE
 - MIND - COVETOUS
- BBCR - MIND - AVARICE, COVETOUS



– Boldness = daring, courageous

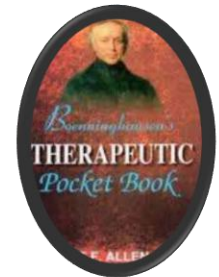
- KENT – BOLDNESS (CR: COURAGEOUS)
 - MIND - COURAGEOUS
 - MIND - AUDACITY (= negative boldness)
- BBCR : MIND - BOLD, AUDACIOUS, BRAZEN, DARING

– Despair = Hopeless

- KENT – MIND – HOPELESS (CR: SADNESS, DESPAIR)
 - MIND - DESPAIR
- BBCR - MIND - DESPAIRING, DISCOURAGED, HOPELESS, etc

- **Excitement * IRRITABILITY**

- **BBCR - MIND - IRRITABLE, CROSS**

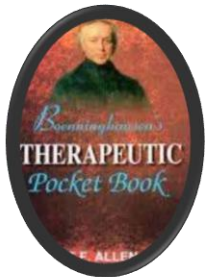


– Fretfulness = peevishness, irritated

- KENT – FRETFUL (CR: IRRITABLE)
 - MIND - IRRITABILITY
- BBCR - MIND - PEEVISH, FRETFUL

– Gentleness = *Mildness

- KENT – MIND – GENTLENESS (CR: MILDNESS)
 - MIND – MILDNESS
- BBCR - MIND - GENTLE, MILD, TENDER



– Haughtiness = Pride

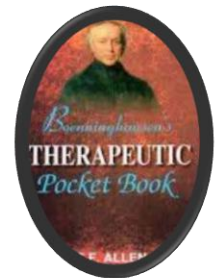
- KENT – MIND – HAUGHTY
- BBCR - MIND - PROUD, ARROGANCE, SELF ESTEEM, HAUGHTY, AIRS, ETC.

– Indifference

- KENT - MIND - INDIFFERENCE, apathy,etc.
- BBCR - MIND - INDIFFERENCE, APATHY

– Joyfulness * Gaiety

- KENT – MIND – JOYOUS(CR: CHEERFULNESS)
– MIND – CHEERFULNESS
- BBCR - MIND - GAIETY, JOYFULNESS

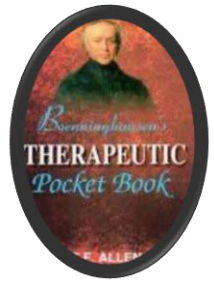


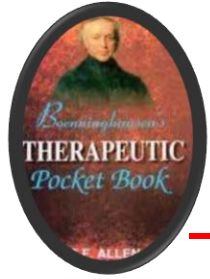
– Mischievousness = to annoy * Maliciousness

- KENT – MIND – MISCHIEVOUS
 - MIND - MALICIOUS
- BBCR - MIND – MISCHIEVOUSNESS (Ars)
 - MIND - MALICIOUS, WICKED

– Mistrust = lack of confidence

- KENT – MIND – SUSPICIOUS; MIND – DOUBTFUL
- BBCR - MIND - MISTRUST, SUSPICION, DOUBT





— Sadness

- KENT – MIND - SADNESS, mental depression
- BBCR - MIND - SADNESS, MELANCHOLY, etc.

— Seriousness

- KENT – MIND - SERIOUS
- BBCR - MIND - SERIOUS

INTELLECT

– Activity * Excitement

- KENT - MIND - EXCITEMENT, excitable
- BBCR - MIND - EXCITEMENT

– Befogged = confusion – not in KR, BBCR

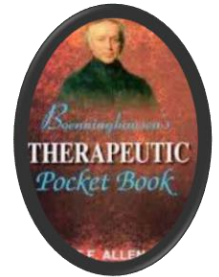
- KENT - MIND - CONFUSION of mind
- BBCR - MIND - CONFUSED, BEFUDDLED, MUDDLED, etc.

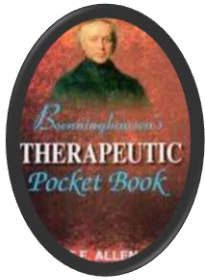
– Comprehension difficult = Dullness

- KENT - MIND - DULLNESS, sluggishness, difficulty of thinking and COMPREHENDING
- BBCR - MIND - COMPREHENSION, ETC. - DIFFICULT

– Delirium

- KENT - MIND – DELIRIUM
- BBCR - MIND - DELIRIUM, FRENZY





– **Ecstasy** = A state of emotion so intense that one carried beyond thought and self-control

- KENT - MIND – ECSTASY
- BBCR - MIND - ECSTASY

– **Imaginations** = fantastic illusions

- KENT - MIND - DELUSIONS, - imaginations, hallucinations, illusions
- BBCR - MIND - Imaginations, fancies, fixed ideas

– **Imbecility** = Feeble minded person with defect in mental ability

- KENT - MIND - IMBECILITY
- BBCR - MIND - IMBECILITY, WEAK MIND

– **Impaired** = affections of intellect in general – not in KENT, BBCR

– Insanity

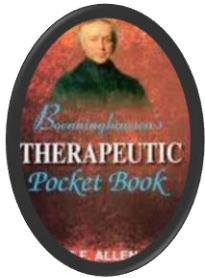
- KENT - MIND - INSANITY, madness
- BBCR - MIND - INSANITY, IRRATIONAL

– Memory

- KENT - MIND - MEMORY active; weakness
- BBCR - MIND – MEMORY

– Stupefaction = spaced out or empty feeling

- KENT - MIND - STUPEFACTION
- BBCR - MIND - STUPEFIED, DAZED



- **Unconsciousness**

- Misplaced rubric – should be under sensations

- KENT - MIND – UNCONSCIOUSNESS

- GENERALS - FAINTNESS, fainting

- BBCR - SENSORIUM - Faintness, fainting, etc.

- **Vertigo**

- no separate chapter

- Misplaced - should be under Sensation

- **Drugs which have concomitants of mental symptoms**
