- LARYNX, TRACHEA
- THROAT PIT
 - Also in Ext Throat
- EPIGLOTTIS
- VOCAL CORDS, VOICE - Hoarseness
- CROUP
- Air passages
 - TPB – AIR PASSAGES as chapter

- Food goes in to larynx on swallowing
 - L&T, food
- Nasal regurgitation
 - Throat, Food, passes in to chonae
 - Throat, Liquid, taken are forced to nose
 - Nose, Liquid,...
- Nodules of vocal cord
 - L&T, Polyps larynx
- T B larynx
 - L & T, Phthisis

- **Hold** the larynx on coughing
 - L&T, Supports
 - **Hold head on coughing**???
- **Grasp the larynx** while coughing
 - Cough, Grasping
 - L&T Pain larynx, coughing on

- ☐ Child **grasp the nurse** when carried
 - ☐ VERTIGO - CHILD grasps the nurse when carried
- ☐ Child **grasp the genitals** & cry out
 - ☐ BLADDER - URGING to urinate (morbid desire) - painful
children grasp the genitals and cry out: Acon. merc.

- LARYNGISMUS stridulus
 - Asthma Milleri or Miller's Asthma
- IRRITATION in air passages
 - TPB – AIRPASSAGES
- OEDEMA glottidis
 - From burns or cardiac insufficiency
- VOICE - broken, attempting to sing

RESPIRATION : KENT

- ASTHMATIC, DIFFICULT, RATTLING
- SIGHING, GASPING, SNORING, SOBBING, PANTING
- HOT BREATH
 - COLD BREATH
 - MOUTH - COLD breath
 - Offensive Breath
 - MOUTH - ODOR (breath), - offensive

- Coma
 - Respiration, Accelerated ascending coma during
 - Sleep, Comatose
- ASPHYXIA – newborn infant
- CATCHING
 - Pneumothorax
- ASTHMATIC – hay asthma
 - Hay fever - Nose, Coryza, annual..
- RESPIRATION - ASTHMATIC - heart - fatty degeneration of heart; from – **Arn.**
- RESPIRATION - DIFFICULT - diseased conditions of distant parts not involved in act of breathing: Puls

- IRREGULAR - slow, at another time hurried; at one time
 - Cheyne-Stokes Respiration
- Breath stopped
 - Resp. Arrested
- Amplitude of breath unequal
 - Resp, intermitent

- TIME MODALITIES, COLOUR, NATURE, ODOR, TASTE ETC.
- Expectoration, Side, is easier after turning from left to right

CHEST : KENT

- Lungs, Pleura, Bronchial Tubes, Hepatisation Of Lungs (Pneumonia), Phthisis (TB)
- Heart, Hypertrophy Of Heart, Valves, Major Blood Vessels
- Mammae, Nipples, Milk
- Clavicle, Sternum, Ribs
- Pectoral Muscles, Intercostal Muscles Etc.

- PHTHISIS pulmonalis = TB
- PHTHISIS pulmonalis – florida
 - Full blown case of TB = Galloping Consumption
- PHTHISIS pulmonalis – incipient
 - Beginning stage = primary complex
- PHTHISIS pulmonalis – pituitous
 - With more phlegm
- PHTHISIS pulmonalis - stone-cutters
