- ERUPTION B/W BUTTOCKS ie; NATES
- CERVICAL, DORSAL, LUMBAR, SACRAL, COCCYX
- SCAPULA
- SPINE
- GLANDS OF NAPE OF NECK(POST)

- BIFIDA
  - Spina Bifida
- Skin of neck brown and greasy
  - BACK BROWN spots on skin of neck brown and greasy
- EMPROSTHOTONOS
- OPISTHOTONOS
- Spinal meningitis
- Cerebral meningitis
  - HEAD INFLAMMATION of brain meninges
- SPASMODIC drawing Cervical region (head bent backward)
- SWELLING Dorsal region
  - Buffalo hump

- Curvature spine
  - dorsal(kyphosis)
- Softening of cord (Myelomalacia)
  - HEAD SOFTENING of brain
    - senility or general paralysis of the insane (GPI) which is tertiary syphilis. Also used for cerebral haemorrhage/stroke.
