 Actively follows bad manners that may offend or annoy other people.

AILMENTS FRO

Civilized people behaving in an uncivilized manner

INSOLENT

- No consideration for others ; LACK OF RESPECT
- PROUD in an overbearing manner
- Rudeness is more crude than Insolent


HAUGHTY

- Arrogantly proud Show off more than he really is
- Great feeling of one's own worth
- They will not misbehave with others



CONTEMPTOUS

- "He looks down on people working under him. however he is very pleasing and calm to his superiors "
- Consider others WORTHLESS or give less importance to others
 - CONTEMPTUOUS Will misbehave
 - CIC, PLAT
 - HAUGHTY will not misbehave
 - LYC, PLAT, SULPH, VERAT



- Showing superiority of self = HAUGHTY
- Showing superiority + Insulting others regarding them as inferior = CONTEMPTUOUS
- Being contemptuous towards someone who ought to be

respected = INSOLENCE

HARSHNESS

- UNFEELING K ANAC
- Having no feeling of kindness or sympathy
- See <u>Cruelty</u> and <u>Moral Feeling</u>

• A sick teenager who filmed himself killing two kittens by placing them inside an airtight bag and using a vacuum cleaner to suck

out the air





• CRUELTY (See Moral feeling, Malicious) : Abrot., absin., Anac., croc.,

cur., nux-v., op., plat.

- Usually used in children
- Causes great harm to others/ merciless
- Real element of PLEASURE involved
- CR MISCHIEVIOUS delight in someone others sufferings
 - Not sadist; MERELY TO AMUSE

- MORAL feeling, want, of : *Anac.*, bism., cocc., coloc., con., croc., cur., hyos., *kali-br.,* lac-c., *laur.,* op., sabad.
 - Does systematic immoral & anti-social acts
 - Indifferent to rights & feelings of others
 - Feel a need to cause harm for others



• Anti-social S/M + Revenge

- Prompted by some slight cause or emotional frustration
- Never forgive or forget





- A patient while telling the symptoms uses insulting words
- Uses as a routine
- Scolding, railing BBCR

- scolds until the lips are blue and eyes stare and she falls down fainting : *Mosch*.

• ABUSIVE: Habit of employing harsh insulting

languages as a routine.

• CURSING : Is due to some provocation by

somebody or some provocative ideas

SWEARING : Cursing after heated exchange with

another one - See Cursing
