SELFISHNESS K

- Thinks only of himself NO SHARING
- All that matters are his own deeds & his own wellbeing, overlooks interests of other people
- · Eating sweets alone, doesn't share with his friends
- Also wants toys of his brother & sister

SUSPICIOUS K

- DISTRUSTFUL (See Suspicious) K
- Suspecting or inclined to suspect
- Distrustful people are always suspecting a wrong being done to them, without sufficient evidence or proof

ENVY K

 Resentful/ Malicious desire possession or advantages.

• This is felt when a person desiring something is deprived of it and sees another person having those things which he has longed for



- According Docks & Kocklenberg, Envy is more materialistic but jealousy is more sexual




Envy
