FEARLESS : total absence of fear in a situation where normal individual would feel frightened.. Standing in front of danger without fear...

COURAGEOUS ^K

Courageous person has the ability to control his fear in a dangerous or difficult situation. He may feel fear within, but he doesn't not escape from a dangerous situation and face it boldly. He only shows his boldness when it is the need to fight, unlike audacious and fearless people who may show their boldness unnecessarily.

- MIND – BED – jumps out of, wants to destroy himself
but lacks courage: ^K (1) chin.
- MIND – BED, – jumps out of, wants to destroy himself
but lacks courage . and runs recklessly about: ^K (1)
sabad.
- MIND – SUICIDAL disposition – lacks courage, but: ^K (8)
alum. CHIN. nit-ac. NUX-V. phos. plat. rhus-t. tab.

AUDACITY^K

- Doing something risky due to **overconfidence** or **arrogance**; **NEGATIVE BOLDNESS**
- It is not due to hastiness....
- **Bold, audacious, brazen, daring**^B

PRESUMPTUOUS^K

- Bold and overconfident
- Lyc
 - Due to CONTEMPTUOUS nature

INDISCRETION K



INDISCRETION ^K

- Lacking good judgement or understanding

For example, if one knows swimming well and dares to rescue someone from water during flood, is **'courageous'**. If it is attempted by someone who doesn't know swimming, then it is an **'indiscretion'**. But if someone tries to cross a flooded river to show his boldness or being challenged, then he is **'audacious'**. If someone enjoys swimming in a dangerous looking flooded river without feeling any fear with a cool mind; he is **'fearless'**.



RASHNESS : extremely hurried in doing something which may have dangerous consequences... Driving car in a dangerous way due to hurriedness...



RECKLESS : doing something dangerously due to inconsideration... 😊😊

TEMERITY S

- Disregard of danger/ Reckless.

- It will be evident in driving, quarrelling, drinking and putting their nose in to issues.
- Audacity is similar but Temerity may lead to some **risky ventures** that may end in success. Though they are reckless& heedless in their activities, **finally he will succeed.**

- Excessively Bold – FEARLESS
- Genuinely/ Reasonably Bold – COURAGEOUS
- Arrogantly/ Negatively Bold – AUDACITY
- Carelessly Bold – RECKLESS
 - But will Succeed – TEMERITY
- Hastily Bold – RASHNESS
- Foolishly Bold – INDISCRETION
