# OBSTINATE <sup>K</sup>

- **Remain stuck** to what they want or think to do and don't change them at all despite argument or persuasion, which may annoy others
  - Self willed persons
  - Usually used in **bad/ negative sense**
  - May end in negative reaction like rage, suicidal attempt etc

# POSITIVENESS <sup>K</sup>

- OBSTINACY + EXCESSIVE SELF CONFIDENCE

- No doubt – Sure of himself or others
- No underlying feel of insecurity
- Knows he is right

# PERTINACITY <sup>K</sup>

- “NEVER GIVE UP”
- Ambitious people have strong desire for success, achievement, fame, honour, power or wealth
- They try to make their dream successful by their effort  
unlike a daydreamer
- Too strong willed
- PERTINACITY: (3) caps. dros. stram.



- **PERTINACITY** usually believes in adherence
- **OBSTINACY** in resistance.
  - Deciding to do something and remaining stuck to it unreasonably
- Pertinacity is often used in a good sense; obstinacy generally in a bad one.

A mix of courage, conviction, and a little obstinacy  
a prerequisite for success

MIND - WILL - strong will power <sup>S</sup>

- WILL - contradiction of: <sup>K</sup> acon. **ANAC.** caps. naja sep.
- WILL - muscles refuse to obey the will when attention is turned away: <sup>K</sup> (1) *Hell.*
- WILL - two, feels as if he had two wills: <sup>K</sup> **ANAC.** *Lach.*

- WILL - deficient <sup>K</sup> (See Irresolution)
