- MIND – THREATENING: (3) *Hep. Stram.* TARENT.
- Declaring an intention or determination to inflict punishment, loss, pain or other evil on another.
- Mind; insanity, madness; threatening destruction and death: (1)
TARENT.
- Mind; kill, desire to; threatens to: (2) *Hep. Tarent.*

MALICIOUS ^K

• “ IF SOMEONE OFFENDS ME, I NEVER FORGET”

- Lengthy history of Malice
- Will neither Forgive or Forget



• "Harboring enmity **without provocation**; disposed to injure others **without cause**, from mere personal gratification; unprovoked malignity or spite."

• **RESENTMENT** ^K – MALICIOUS + REVENGEFUL ([See Malicious](#))

- Mind; insanity, madness; malignant ^K (1) : *Cupr*
= malicious
- Mind; plans; revengeful: ^K (1) agar,
- Mind; MALICIOUS, WICKED; ^B
- CR ^B – SPITEFUL (MALICIOUS); WICKED (MALICIOUS)

HATRED^K

- Great dislike or aversion; enmity
- result from perceived "offenses or injuries" done by fellow men"
- MALICIOUS – Unprovoked
- HATRED – Provoked
- Mind: HATRED AND REVENGE^B



MISANTHROPY K



- **Generalised and Settled Hatred**, a disposition either provoked or unprovoked; deeper and broader antipathy than mere "Company, aversion to".
- **HATRED TOWARDS MANKIND**
- **ANTHROPOPHOBIA – FEAR TOWARDS PEOPLE**
 - ([See Fear](#)) men. of ([See People](#))

WICKED DISPOSITION ^K



- EXTREME MALICIOUSNESS

- In Perverse or abnormal people
- Do great harm to life of people
- Thieves, murderers
- NO GUILT or REGRET



- Pinocchio, an animated puppet, is punished for each lie that he tells by undergoing further growth of his nose. It grows as he tells lies and at one point grows so long that he can not even get his nose "through the door of the room".

- LIE, never speaks the truth, does not know what she is saying^K : Op., verat.

- believes all she says is a : Lact-ac.

- UNTRUTHFUL^K : Alco., op., verat.

Mind; LIES HABITUALLY;^B op, verat,



KLEPTOMANIA ^K



- a recurrent urge to steal, typically without regard for need or profit; that the person not needs
- steals dainties : Mag-m., nat-c.
- steals money : Calc.



DECEITFUL ^K

- Intended to **mislead** – disposition than simple lying
- Mind: **DECEIT CUNNING, KRYPTOMANIA** ^B
 - CR – CUNNING, LYING



HYPOCRISY: K phos.

- A feigning to be **WHAT ONE IS NOT**
- Concealment of one's real character or motives
- **AFFECTATION** – can be identified easily; – an attempt
- **HYPOCRISY** – more subtle in pretending – cannot be identified easily, and successful in pretention

MORAL FEELING WANT OF K

- NO CONSCIENCE

- Appears to have no sense of right or wrong

- Mind; MORAL FEELING LACK OF; ^B (2) anac. laur.

CRUELTY ^K

- **HARDHEARTED** ^K (See Cruelty)
- IN CHILDREN
- Delight in someone else sufferings
- **BUT NOT A SADDIST**



- Mind; unfeeling, hard-hearted: ^K (1) ANAC,
- Mind; joy; misfortune of others, at ^K: (1) ars,
- Mind; Cut, others desire to: ^K : lyss,



- MIND- CRUELTY, HARDNESS OF HEART ^B

MISCHIEVOUS ^K

- HARM ANIMALS & HUMANS WITHOUT A SECOND THOUGHT
- Harmfully or **DESTRUCTIVELY NAUGHTY**

- Mind; MISCHIEVOUSNESS; ^B (1) ars,

- MIND, MISCHIEVIOUSNESS ^T
