- MIND – FORSAKEN feeling

(MIND – HELPLESSNESS, feeling of )

- Feeling of being left alone when most needed

- Lack of support and care when one cannot look after oneself

- sensation of isolation

- When I was four years of age and I had to walk home alone after kindergarten:

- “I feel all alone in the world.
- I am not as important as my colleagues at work.
- My parents favored my brother;
- No one understands me.
- I have no family in the world and no one to help me.

- Those statements could all be **true or realistic perceptions.**

- MIND – DELUSIONS, – affection of friends, has lost: (2)

- MIND – DELUSIONS, – alone, that she is always – she is, in the world: (4) *camph. hura Plat. Puls.*

- MIND – DELUSIONS, – appreciated, that she is not: (2) *Pall.*

*plat.*



# DELUSIONS

- Misrepresentation of reality in their life
- Their misinterpretation or misrepresentation of the event will form the basis of their mental and emotional 'baggage' they carry with them.
- In homoeopathy we develop a case around this primary event and we call it the 'never-well-since-symptom' of the case.

# DELUSION OF PERSECUTION

## • Delusion of REFERENCE

- People are talking of him / slandering him / spying on him
- MIND - DELUSIONS, - persecuted, that he is: <sup>K</sup> (6) CHIN. cycl. DROS. hyos. kali-br. stram.
- MIND - DELUSIONS, - appreciated, that she is not : <sup>K</sup> (2) Pall. plat.
- MIND - DELUSIONS - pursued; he was
- MIND - DELUSIONS - talking - people talk about her
- MIND - DELUSIONS - talking - friends are talking about her: (1) lach.
- MIND - SUSPICIOUS - talking about her, that people are: <sup>K</sup> (1) Bar-c.

# DELUSION OF GUILT

- In patients with severe depression
- Feel they are extremely wicked thus, **it is justified** to spy on him; believe that they are bad or evil. And have ruined their family
- MIND - DELUSIONS, - wrong, fancies he has done<sup>K</sup>
- MIND - DELUSIONS - criminal, he is a<sup>K</sup>
- MIND - DELUSIONS, - crime - as if he had committed<sup>K</sup>
- MIND - DELUSIONS - reproach, neglected duty & deserves<sup>K</sup> *Aur.*

# Delusion of INFIDELITY

- Incorrectly As **delusion of JEALOUSY**
- Have morbid jealousy instead of delusion of jealousy
- Can occur in both organic and functional disorders; also very common in alcohol dependence
- **MIND - DELUSIONS - wife - faithless; wife is: (2) hyos. stram.**
- **MIND - DELUSIONS - wife - run away from him; wife will: (1) staph.**



# Delusion of LOVE

- Fantasy lover syndrome & Erotomania.
- MALE GENITALIA – SEXUAL PASSION – excessive
- MIND – NYMPHOMANIA
- The patient is convinced that someone is in Love with them although the alleged lover may have never spoken to them
- May be a part of Schizophrenia



# DELUSION OF GRANDIOSITY

- Primary are seen in schizophrenia
- Secondary in mania.



- He believes that **HE IS SPECIAL OR HAS SPECIAL POWERS.**

- **MIND - DELUSIONS, - superhuman, - is: (I) cann-i.**

- **MIND - DELUSIONS - great person, is a**

- **MIND - DELUSIONS, - emperor, - thought himself an: (I) cann-i.**



# NIHILISTIC DELUSION



- The patient denies the existence of their body, their mind, their loved ones and the world around them.

**A mental disorder called Cotard's Syndrome (also known as the Cotard Delusion, the Nihilistic Delusion, and the Walking Corpse Syndrome) causes sufferers to believe that they are dead and do not exist.**

- MIND – DELUSIONS, – existence, – doubted his own: (I) cann-i.
- MIND – DELUSIONS – dead – he himself was
- MIND – DELUSIONS – dead – he himself was – half dead,  
half alive
- MIND – DELUSIONS – dead – he himself was – funeral; and  
preparations were being made for her: (I) lach.
- MIND – DELUSIONS, – bells, hears ringing of – his funeral: (I)  
*Aether*
- MIND – DELUSIONS – dead – child was, her

# DELUSION OF POVERTY

- The patient is convinced that they are impoverished and believe that destitution is facing them and their family.
- MIND - DELUSIONS - poor; he is
- MIND - DELUSIONS - fortune, he was going to lose his
- MIND - DELUSIONS - starve - being starved

# HYPOCHONDRIACAL DELUSION

- Delusion of Ill health / Somatic delusions
  - Patients believe that they have some serious illness
  - patient may also feel his body is diseased or changed

• MIND - DELUSIONS - sick - being

• MIND - ANXIETY - hypochondriacal

• MIND - DELUSIONS - disease - unrecognized

# DELUSION OF INFESTATION

- Ekboms syndrome
- Patient believes that he is infested with small but macroscopic organisms.
- MIND - DELUSIONS, - insects, sees
- MIND - DELUSIONS, - animals, of - creeping of - in her: (1) stram.





# DELUSION OF CONTROL



- The core belief of the patient is that he is no longer in sole control of his own body, thoughts, feelings, impulses or behavior.
- MIND - DELUSIONS, - influence, is under a powerful: (2) cere-b.

*Lach.*



# DELUSION OF MISIDENTIFICATION

- Capgras syndrome / Fregoli syndrome
- believes that a person usually closely related has been replaced by an exact double.
- Fregolis syndrome the delusional misidentification of an unfamiliar person as a familiar one, even though there is no physical resemblance.

- MIND - DELUSIONS, - person, - thinks - she is some other
- MIND - DELUSIONS, - person, - thinks - that he is two  
persons

# RELIGIOUS DELUSIONS

- Patient is preoccupied with false beliefs of religious nature, such as antichrist.
- MIND - RELIGIOUS AFFECTIONS - too occupied with religion
- MIND - DELUSIONS - Christ, himself to be
- MIND - DELUSIONS - divine, being
- MIND - DELUSIONS - Mary; Virgin - she is

- MIND - DELUSIONS, - beautiful: (5) bell. *Cann-i coca Lach.*  
*Sulph.*

- MIND - DELUSIONS, - body - erroneous ideas as to the  
state of his: (1) **SABAD.**
