- Never happy/ satisfied with what they have or achieved
- DISSATISFIED K
- DISPLEASED K



FROWN, DISPOSED TO K

• Expression of DISPLEASURE, deep thought, irritation

- MIND INDIFFERENCE answer, indifference when questioned, says nothing; aversion to: ^S (1) Colch.
- FACE WRINKLED Forehead K
 - Sign of age, migraine, cerebral ds





- Without any good reason, they often find someone or something to complain about
 - If the train is late, they bore other passengers with the complains
- Constant GRUMBLING ^K പിറുപിറുക്കൽ
- Seems to be a CRITIC, but not so
 - Constantly telling the doctor about the interminable list of complaints,

• MIND - TORMENTS everyone with his complaints: ZINC.

MOANING K

- Piteous sound one makes when he is suffering from pain, grief, distress etc
- ഞരങ്ങുക



LAMENTING K

- Person moans, cries & sighs as though in great distress and pain, but he does so to arouse sympathy from those
 - around him

SHRIEKING K

- MIND SHRIEKING brain cry (cri-encephali)
- MIND SHRIEKING pleased; hard to be:^{\$} (1) ip.

MOROSE K

- Unhappy, Bad tempered; Ill humour,
- GLOOMY ^K; (See Sadness)
- FRETFUL ^K; (See Irritable)
- SULLEN ^K, CR SULKY ^K
- UNFRIENDLY humor ^K: (3) am-c. mag-m. plat.
- Not talking much
- more of a quality of chronicity

GLOOMY K

 SADNESS ^K is more of an inner state of experience. and can be used as synonym to depression

DEPRESSION

DISCOURAGED K

• When someone has diminished hope or

enthusiasm due to some failure or being unsuccessful

or by any other obstacle

The much enthusiasm he previously had, now diminished

due to some reason

DESPAIR K

Total loss of hope

• HOPELESS K (See Sadness, Despair)

GRIEF K

- Grief extreme sadness (more deeper) for eg: after sudden death of near or dear one
 - MIND GRIEF ailments, from K
 - MIND GRIEF ailments, from cannot cry: (2) Gels.
 - NAT-M.

- INCONSOLABLE ^K is often related to the concept of Grief.
- MIND INCONSOLABLE over fancied misfortune: VERAT.

 One thinks deeply and for a long time about some awful which is ongoing or happened
 currently, that makes him sad, upset or angry

BROODING K over failure

Being occupied with things in the past
DWELLING K

- Weeping outburst of emotions through shedding of tears
- Lamenting outburst of emotions through words
- Brooding no outburst of emotion, it is an inside thought (recent events)
 - Dwelling past events
- Grief extreme sadness (more deeper) for eg: due to death of near or dear one
 - Inconsolable: "Love. Ailments From Disappointed"- means ailments from disappointed love

WEARY OF LIFE K

- Bored feeling towards life as they start feeling as if they have experienced too much of it
- Feels tired, wants mental rest

- Weary after long continued stressful examination

LOATHING / ENNUI K

- These people develop reluctance towards life because it becomes no longer enjoyable to them.
- They develop an unwillingness to live because life is not pleasurable to them
- Nothing excites them

- Leads to Suicidal disposition
