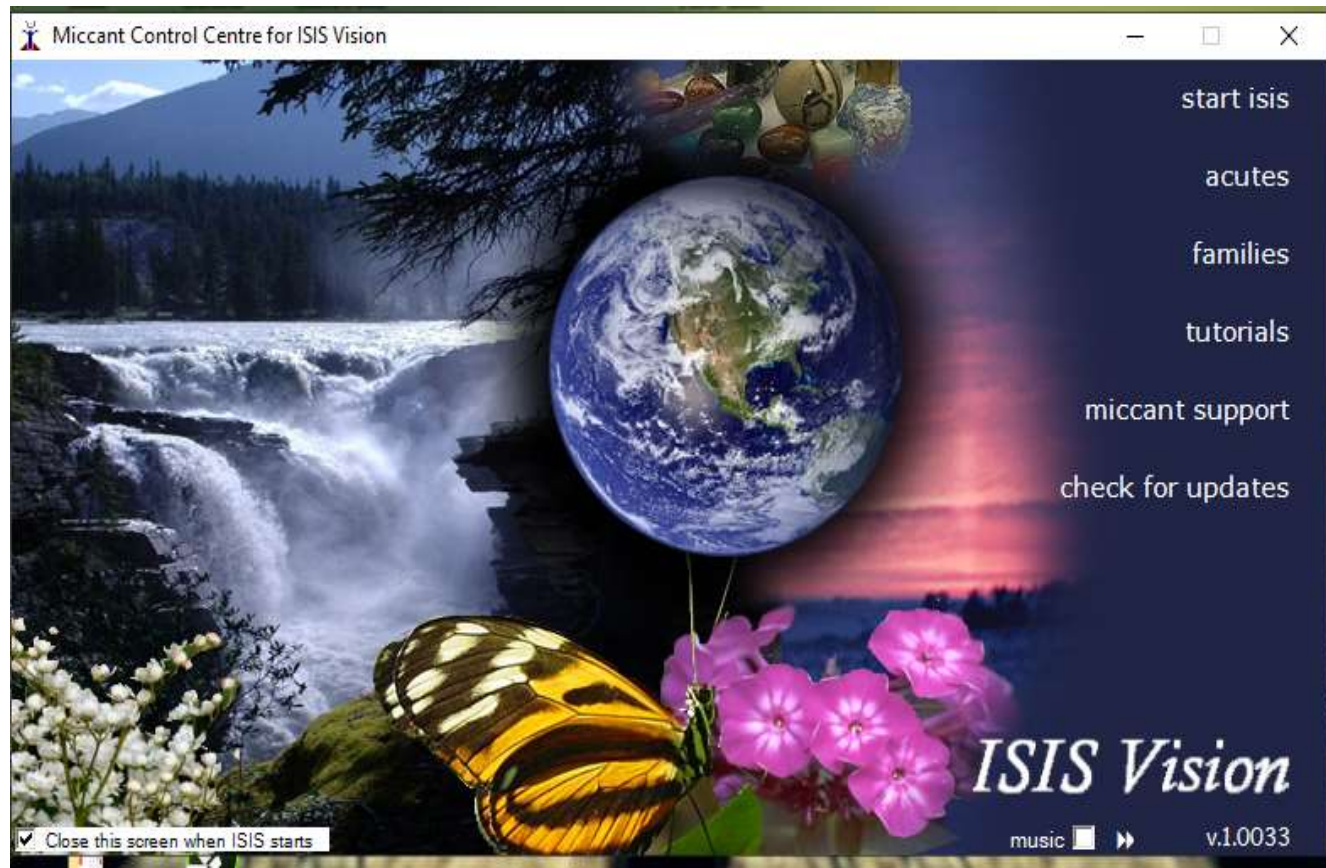

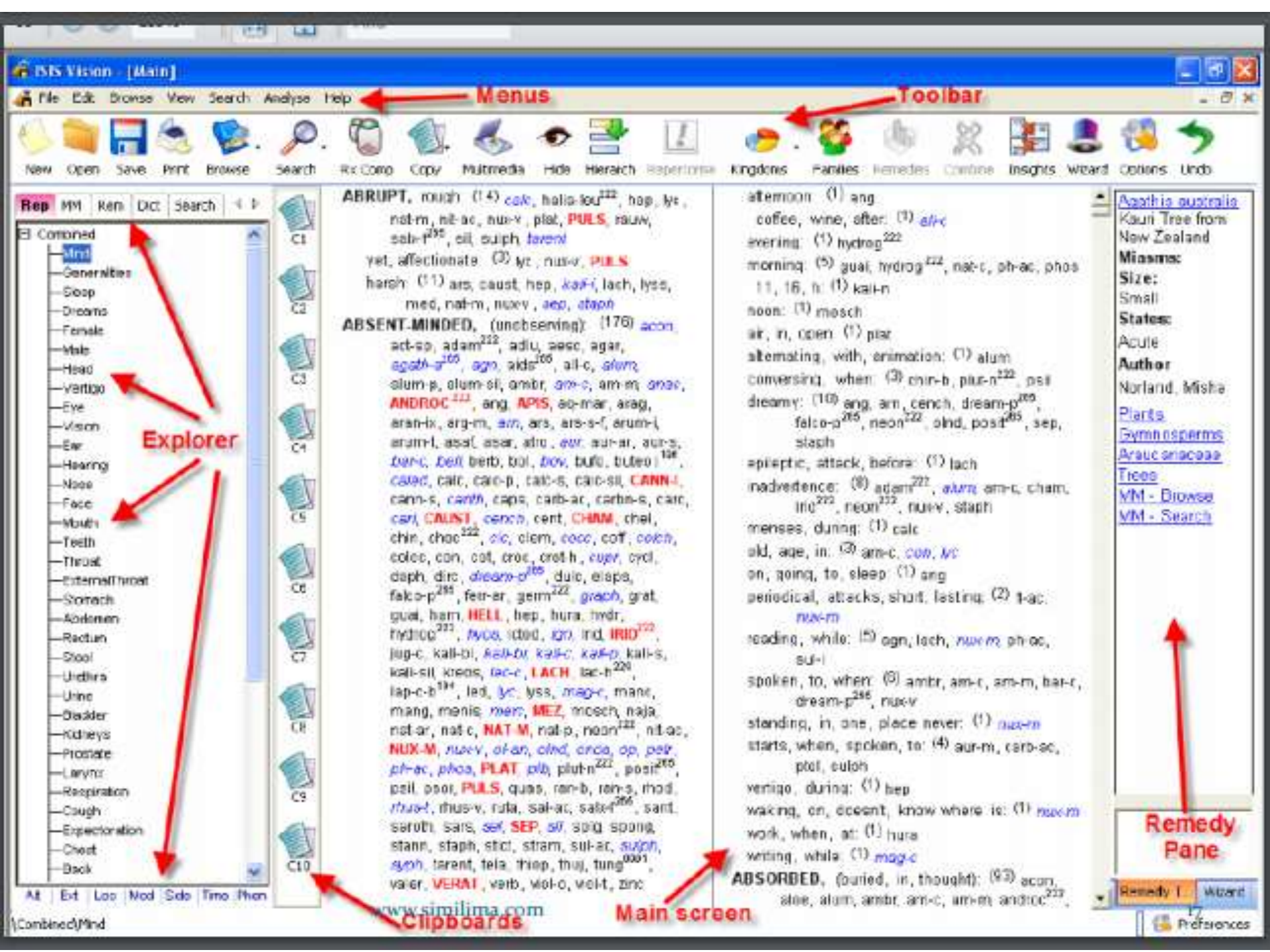
Where all book data is displayed like

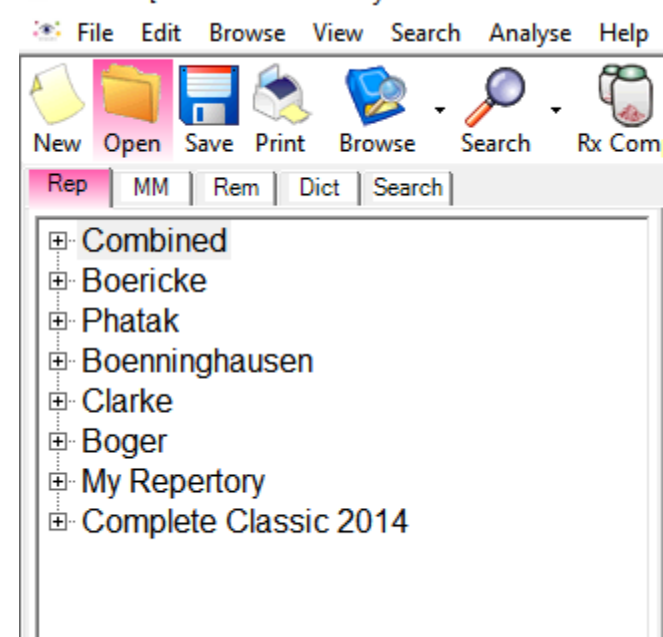

- Where we can add our notes under sections like

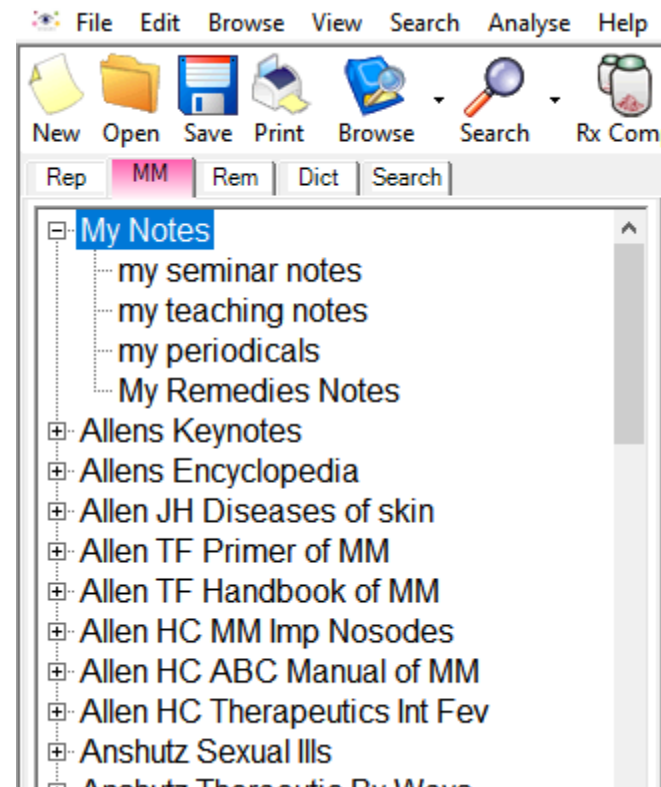
