**Hockey University Online Course Dates 2017-18:** 

Safety: February 28th/2018

Coaching: Closes February 28th/2018

Officiating: Closes December 31st/2017

### **Notes for each course:**

(Coach Level 1) – To obtain Coach 1 trained status, coaches must complete the Hockey Canada University online course.

The cost of the online and in-class course is \$70.00.

We advise you to check with your MHA President before registering for the online course, MHAs may cover fees or have a payment plan set-up within your association.

Please note you only need to complete the Hockey U Online Course once, this online course is a prerequisite for the in-class for Coach Level 1 & 2.

#### **Additional Notes for Coach Level 1:**

- 1. To sign-up for online Hockey University CLICK HERE \*Please note new users will have to set- up an account.
- 2. Certification is not required at the Coach 1 Level. All coaches at the IP level will require Coach Level 1 Training. The cost of the course if you already have your online portion completed in a previous season is \$40.00.
- 3. Coach Level 1 is not a prerequisite to Coach Level 2. Coach Level 1 is only required for coaches at the Initiation Program Level (5 & 6).

(Coach Level 2) - To obtain Coach 2 trained status, coaches must complete the Hockey Canada University online course. The cost of the online and in-class course is \$86.00.

We advise you to check with your minor hockey association President before registering for the online course, MHAs may cover fees or have a payment plan set-up within your association.

Please note you only need to complete the Hockey U Online Course once, this online course is a prerequisite for the in-class for Coach Level 1 & 2.

The cost of the in-class course if you already have your online portion completed in a previous season is \$55.00.

#### **Additional Notes for Coach Level 2:**

- 1. To sign-up for online Hockey University CLICK HERE \*Please note new users will have to set- up an account.
- 2. Certification is not required at the Coach 2 Level. Once you have completed Coach Level 2 you are now eligible to register for a Development 1 coaching course.

Coaches wishing to take the Development 1 course must complete the Coach Level 2 course prior to registering for the Development 1 course.

(Under Hockey Canada guidelines only one of these courses – Coach 2 and Development 1 - can be completed each hockey season).

**Development 1:** At least one member of the coaching staff must be D1 certified for Provincial Tournaments. (Refer to Coaching Requirements Chart)

To become Development 1 certified a coach must:

- 1. Attend the in-class clinic (12-14 hours)
- 2. Complete the post task work book (signed off by MHA TD/President & Course Facilitator)
- 3. Complete the Online Making Ethical Decisions Course MED Competition Introduction
- \*The MED course will be offered for free once a coach is registered into the Locker national database & workbook is completed.

**High Performance 1:** This course is for advanced coaches and is a weeklong course offered yearly throughout Canada.

The HP1 course is offered every two years in Atlantic Canada.

#### **HU Checking:**

- 1. Cost is \$15.00 (Hockey U online checking course only needs to be completed once)
- 2. Course is completed online
- 3. See chart for coaches who are <u>required</u> to take this course (please note coaches outside these requirements can still take the course but is not mandatory)

#### **Goaltending 1 In-Class:**

- 1. \$40.00 Attend in-class Goaltending 1 course (No online portion)
- 2. 3 hours in-class + 1 hour on-ice
- 3. See chart for coaches who are required to take this course (please note coaches outside these requirements can still take the course but is not mandatory)
- 4. Please note this course does not permit Goaltending coaches to be on the bench during games, only practices. Speak out, Criminal Check and HNL Screening Required for registered goaltender coaches.

All coaches, trainers and managers must complete the Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders (available online) This is also requirement to become a coach at any level.

## **Coaching Age Requirements:**

Coach Level 1 = 16 Years of Age (IP Level 5 & 6)

Coach Level 2 = 18 Years of Age

**Development 1 = 19 Years of Age** 

Respect in Sport/Speak Out = 16 years of Age

**Goaltending 1 Clinic:** 16 Years of Age **HU Online Checking:** 16 Years of Age
