
- 11 million (19%) disabled people

UK


- 1.2 million wheelchair users

NIGERIA

- 25 million (14%) disabled people
- No data for total wheelchair users
- Polio eradicated in 2015
- 7000 polio related paralysis (in need of wheelchair) 2011

BUILDINGS


- Inaccessible public buildings



- Misallocation of funds


