Girl Scout Cookies from the USA

In the talk Dhamanathy gave we heard about the "Travel Back in Time with us" patch that Girl Scouts for the girls to take part in. This included activities from the different eras of Guiding and the one from 1912-1919 was to 'bake a cookie'

Did you know that the first cookie sale was held by a patrol (troop) in Muskogee, Oklahoma in December 1917?

Bake a shortbread cookie that would have been sold at the time!

An early Girl Scout ® Recipe

1 cup of butter

1 cup sugar plus additional amount for topping (optional)

2 eggs

2 tablespoons milk

1 teaspoon vanilla

2 cups flour

1 teaspoon salt

2 teaspoons baking powder

Cream butter and a cup of the sugar;

Add well-beaten eggs, then milk, vanilla & flour, salt and baking powder.

Refrigerate for at least 1 hour.

Roll dough, cut into trefoil shapes and sprinkle sugar on the top if desired.

Bake in a quick oven (375deg) for approximately 8 - 10 minutes or until the edges begin to brown.

Makes 6 - 7 dozen cookies.

At the AGM we mentioned that we were waiting for an update on Our Cabana and we have received this from Magdalene,

Firstly, can I say a huge thank you for you kind and generous donation. The Friends of the WAGGGS World Centres have been such a tremendous support to the World Centres for a long time but also especially during COVID. It has really meant a lot to me and the World Centre teams. So, thank you to you and your amazing members.

With regards to your specific questions regarding Our Cabana regretfully, due to the impact of CoVID-19, Guías de México has decided that it can no longer operate Our Cabaña, which it had been doing since 2014 in agreement with WAGGGS. We are currently going through an internal process of carefully reviewing all the possible options for Our Cabana future and working how best to proceed. There are still ongoing maintenance, security and administrative costs to keep Our Cabana hibernating whilst a decision is made, so at this stage that is what the funds would cover. We are expecting the World Board to share their thinking about Our Cabana in June.
