
Welcome to the autumn newsletter from the Friends of the WAGGGS World Centres.


Sending money abroad?

Kim Clegg, the FOWWC Treasurer has found out about **WISE** a service which may be of benefit to some of our members.

Not just for FOWWC membership, but for trips, families and any overseas business.

Here is what Kim has said about WISE: I found an international funds service which you may wish to use. It is provided by a company called Wise (formerly Transfer Wise), and it has been recommended by money advice services here in the UK.

The advantage of this service is that it charges a % fee rather than a fixed amount and it allows you to see what will be charged to your debit card (you can also use a bank transfer to the company) and doesn't then include a further transfer fee.

Our Cabana

Phase 2

In September 2022, following a competitive tender process, Ernst & Young was appointed to evaluate and develop a business case for each of the three options.

Over the next two months, the team from Ernst & Young, based in the USA and Mexico, will review key documentation, meet with key stakeholders, carry out legal, financial, and market research, and produce a written report and a set of recommendations for the World Board.

At its September meeting, the World Board met with the consultants to discuss this work and will meet with them again once the work has been concluded, to consider the findings and agree on a way forward.

A further update will be provided at that stage.

We want to thank all those involved in the process to date, for so kindly sharing their experiences and insights about Our Cabana.



New Zealand trip 2024


for members of the Friends of the WAGGGS World Centres and families


