Jeanne Baret, also known as Jean Baré (her name changed to be a boy name), was a French botanist* and explorer born on the 27th July in 1740, La Comelle. Without knowing, she was the first woman that circumnavigated** around the world from 1766 to 1769. She had to pretend to be a man, because in those times it was forbidden the entrance on the boats for woman, instead they had to be at home taking care of their children and had traditional roles. Her companion was her husband, Philibert Commerson. She studied many new plants in the environment they grew; and she discovered a new plant, so the scientifics named after Baret.



This plant doesn't exist anymore. Philibert died on 1773 because a disease called dysentery. During a year Jeanne was working for getting some money to return to her home. She meet a French soldier that also wanted to return to France called Jean Dubernat. In 1774 they get married. She died on 5th August 1807.

Her story became famous only a few years ago.
