

Making Comparisons

We use comparative adjectives to make comparisons.

RULES	Examples	
Short Adjectives : add -er -or -r For adjectives ending in consonant, vowel, consonant: double the last consonant	old short large big	older shorter larger bigger
Long Adjectives: use more	crowded boring interesting enjoyable	more crowded more boring more interesting more enjoyable
Adjectives ending in -y : add -ier	easy happy noisy heavy	easier happier noisier heavier
Irregular adjectives Some adjectives have irregular forms.	good bad much / many far	better worse more father / further



Positive

I	am	playing ing tennis.
We You They	are	
He She It	is	

Question

Am	I	playing ing tennis?
Are	we you they	
Is	he she it	

Negative

I	am not	playing ing tennis.
We You They	are not / aren't	
He She It	is not / isn't	

Short Answers

Yes, I am. / No, I am not.
Yes, we / you / they are. / No, we / you / they aren't.
Yes, he / she / it is. / No, he / she / it isn't.
