About

- an inter-governmental body within the United Nations system
- strengthening the promotion and protection of <u>human rights</u> around the world.
- created by the United Nations General Assembly in 2006
- · replaced the former United Nations Commission on Human Rights.
- Secretariat: Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR)
- · HQ: Geneva, Switzerland

Members of UNHRC

- Members elected by the UN General Assembly (UNGA): takes into account the candidate States' contribution to the promotion and protection of human rights, as well as their voluntary pledges and commitments.
- 47 United Nations Member States
- Tenure of Member States: three years
- · Members not eligible for immediate re-election after serving two consecutive terms.

BASIS OF MEMBERSHIP

- Membership is based on equitable geographical distribution:
- 1. African States: 13 seats
- 2. Asia-Pacific States: 13 seats
- 3. Latin American and Caribbean States: 8 seats
- 4. Western European and other States: 7 seats
- 5. Eastern European States: 6 seats
