

The Department of Foreign Language and Literature, operating at our university, allows you to study such knowledge in depth.



FOREIGN LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE

FOR WHOM FOREIGN LANGUAGE AND LITERATURE COURSES ARE SUITABLE?



Each applicant who is aimed at in-depth study of a foreign language and teaching it to others can study in this direction.

Training of bachelors in the field of foreign language and literature - bachelor's degree is carried out in the form of a full-time education. Training in all forms of education is organized on the basis of the ECTS credit-module system.

The educational process, pedagogical technologies and teaching methods, methods of teaching English, knowledge of English literature are taught to students of foreign languages and literature by experienced teachers and high-level professors.

The teaching of a foreign language and literature is carried out on the basis of an educational plan and scientific programs (syllabuses) aimed at teaching on the basis of a preparatory bachelor's credit system in the field of bachelor's education. A person who has fully mastered the training in this course, consisting of practical exercises, who has received the specified number of credits and successfully passed the final certification, is awarded the qualification (degree) "bachelor" and an official document (diploma). for higher education.

WHERE CAN GRADUATES OF FOREIGN LANGUAGES AND LITERATURE DEPARTMENTS WORK?

Graduates of this course can work in the following professional areas:

- English teacher in secondary schools;
- English teacher and head of the club of academic lyceums and professional colleges;
- English teacher in preschool educational organizations;
- Specialist of out-of-school educational institutions;
- Teacher of English in non-state educational organizations;
- An employee who can work in the education system in the positions of an office manager, laboratory assistant and equivalent positions;
- A methodologist in ministries, its sectoral departments and institutions providing training in relevant educational areas;
- Junior researcher of humanitarian scientific organizations;
- Work in archives, information resource centers, publishing houses, mass media institutions, manuscript collections, various business entities, non-governmental non-profit and public organizations and other institutions;
- An employee of local governments and local centers of spirituality and education;
- Personnel capable of developing and implementing computer technologies, pedagogy and technology of vocational education, didactic teaching aids, electronic teaching aids in the field of production.

A graduate of the bachelor's degree in foreign languages and literature can continue his studies in the specialties of the master's program in the manner prescribed by the legislation of the Republic of Uzbekistan.
