OBTAINING A MASTER'S DEGREE IN ECONOMICS HAS THE FOLLOWING ADVANTAGES:



- Possession of a system of scientific worldview knowledge, the fundamentals of broad methodological sciences, to be able to independently assess economic issues and processes;
- Comprehending the essence of documents and works relevant to professional activities in one of the foreign languages, knowledge of the methodology of scientific research and teaching, and the capacity to use it in professional activities on a current scientific basis:

- The skill of independently acquiring new information, working on oneself, and organizing work on a scientific basis.
- Being able to conduct a creative, critical assessment and analysis of acquired information and to apply it to scientific activity.
- The competence to use legal documents in their professional activity and to make independent, well-informed judgments;
- Possessing the fundamental techniques and tools for accessing, storing, and processing information from the Internet, and having the ability to use a computer as a tool for information management.
- The capacity to apply digital economy technologies, comprehending the nature and relevance of the digital economy in the information society, comprehending the risks and potential consequences of information attacks, and meeting the fundamental criteria of information security;
- Acquiring a deep expertise in macroeconomics, microeconomics, and econometrics, among other areas of economics.

MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMS IN ECONOMICS (BY FIELDS AND INDUSTRIES)

The Master of Science in Economics is a specialist program that increases your knowledge of economics' core principles, ideas, and concepts. This course is designed for students who have finished their undergraduate studies and seek to further their expertise in this field. In addition, the curriculum is intended to provide students with the opportunity to tailor the theoretical-practical approach to economics to their own aims. A full education in the digital economy, economic analysis, and financial economics are included in this expansive subject of economics. Graduates of the program will develop expertise in applied research and financial analysis, be highly competitive in the financial sector job market, and be prepared for PhD programs.

Master's degree programs in the field of "Economics" are conducted full-time. The organization of education in the form of education is based on the ECTS credit-module system.

70310102 - Economics is conducted in accordance with an educational and scientific program (syllabus) that emphasizes receiving education based on the credit system of higher education training of masters in the area of expertise of the master (ECTS), its theoretical and practical training. A master's degree and an official document (diploma) of the state's higher education standard are awarded to a student who has earned and mastered a certain amount of credits. (120 credits, an average GPA score of 2 or higher).

The curriculum and subject programs of the specialty of the master's program in economics (by fields and industries) are developed taking into account the continuity of the undergraduate course of higher education and the specialty of the master's program, students can study certain blocks of compulsory subjects, intended for development. An internship is offered in order to acquire professional skills. In addition to the mandatory studies, the curriculum includes electives given by the academic department and selected by the students.

Compulsory subjects are 97.5 ECTS and each is 7.5 ECTS. These subjects are: Microeconomics, Research Methodology, Econometrics I and II, Macroeconomic Policy, Industrial Economics, Monetary Policy, Investment Management, Economic Development, and Research and Data Analysis.

Elective subjects are 22.5 ECTS and these subjects also consist of 7.5 ECTS. Also, 7.5 ECTS is allocated for the internship and 15 ECTS for the defense of a master's thesis, and at the end of the course, they gain a maximum of 120 ECTS.

Mastering the curriculum and scientific programs (syllabi) of the magistracy requires students to have independent understanding of a variety of academic concerns and challenges. The program includes practical training in fields linked to the specialty at the university and in fundamental organizations and businesses.

To ensure the integrity of theory and practice, qualified practices and voluntary internships of students in higher education organizations or universities in Finland can be transferred after studying Finnish or English at the required level on the basis of "work and travel," 1+1 programs and obtaining a certificate or document of a specified level.

- to be able to use normative and legal documents in their activities, to be able to make informed independent decisions in their professional activities;
