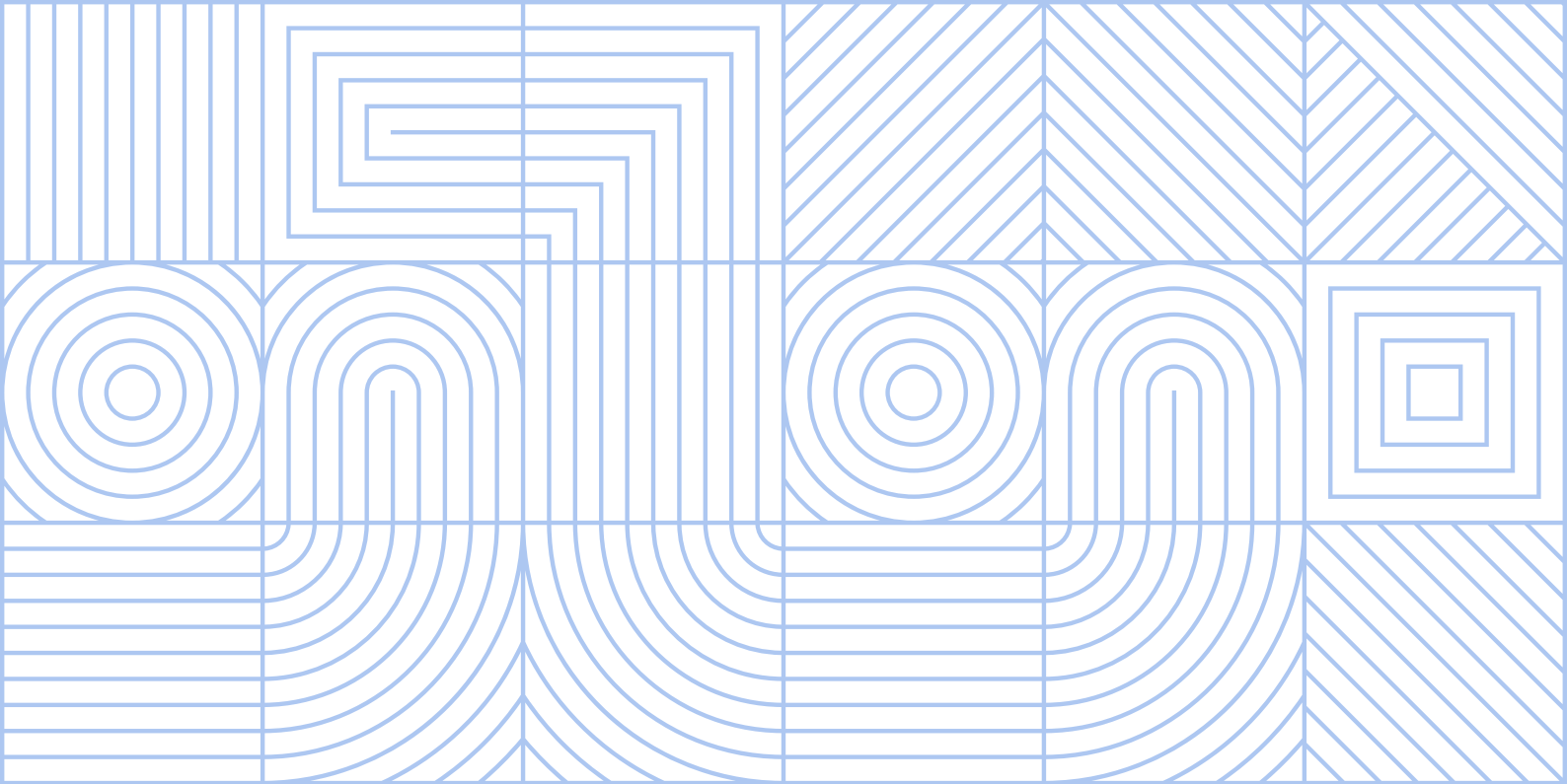

60310900 Psychology (applied psychology), educational areas, the learner must accumulate 30 credits in one semester, 60 credits in one academic year. The duration of study is 4 years, and the student must complete 240 credits before completing the program. One ECTS credit for a student is 30 academic hours, and the student's annual study load is 1800 academic hours. Of this - 40% classroom hours, 60% independent study per hour. The volume of credits to be mastered by the student during the semester includes compulsory and optional subjects specified in the catalog of subjects.
