




WORLD ECONOMY AND INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC RELATIONS



60411900 - The world economy and international economic relations are carried out on the basis of a curriculum and a scientific program (syllabus), focused on training based on the credit system of higher education, which trains personnel in the field of undergraduate studies, its theoretical and personal fully mastered industrial practice, received the specified number of credits (240 credits, GPA 2 and above) a qualification (degree) "bachelor" and an official document of higher education (diploma) are issued.

The curriculum and subject programs of the bachelor's degree in the direction "World Economy and International Economic Relations" will be developed taking into account continuity and consistency with the higher education bachelor's degree course, assimilation by students of blocks of compulsory subjects.



In order to ensure the integrity of theory and practice, qualified practices and voluntary internships for students in institutions of higher education or universities in Finland, after studying Finnish or English at the required level on the principle of "work and travel", 1 + 1 programs and obtaining a certificate or document of the specified level may pass the.



WHAT COMPETENCES WILL HAVE THE STUDENTS?

The benefits of obtaining a bachelor's degree in world economy and international economic relations include:

- collection, processing, analysis and generalization of information about the world economy and international economic relations;
- analysis of development trends and dynamics of the world economy by industry and sector:
- analysis of the world economy and activities of subjects of international economic relations based on the criteria, norms and requirements of international practice;
- assessment and interpretation of financial and statistical reporting of enterprises and organizations engaged in foreign economic activity;
- analysis of indicators of foreign economic activity, trends and dynamics of enterprises and organizations and forecasting their prospects;
- acquire skills such as creating models of the world economy and the economic development of individual countries.





Upon completion of the bachelor's degree in the specialty "World Economy and International Economic Relations". students will:

- know and be able to use the methods and processes of human resource management in the subjects of the world economy and international economic relations;
- know the world experience of rational organization of economic activity of economic entities of our country and use it in practice
- assessment of the activities of local enterprises and organizations engaged in foreign economic activity in the world market for goods and services;
- be able to use in practice the knowledge and experience of assessing external factors affecting the activities of local enterprises and organizations engaged in foreign economic activity;
- have knowledge and experience with economic indicators related to the development of the world economy and international economic relations, and be able to conduct analyzes based on these indicators;
- introduction of modern principles and theoretical foundations of the world economy;
- be able to determine the most rational methods and forms of cooperation in the field of international economic relations;
- be able to scientifically classify and analyze the factors influencing the world economy and international economic relations;
- be able to analyze development trends and dynamics of the global market for goods and services;
- to be able to put into practice the traditional methods of analyzing the world economy and the development of international economic relations;
- acquire skills in the use of modern information technologies and technical means in the financial and economic assessment of the activities of the region, industry, enterprises and organizations involved in international economic relations, and indicators of their development.
