KASTRO KILLINI, GOLDEN COAST 13KM

GLYFA BEACH HOTEL

10 km of sandy beach with many bars, camping sites and taverns along the coastline.

OLYMPIA 70KM

- Olympia is known for hosting the most influential ancient Greek sanctuaries, located in western Peloponnese. The archaeological site, **Ancient Olympia**, includes ruins from Bronze Age to the Byzantine eras.
- You can also find the archeological **Olympia museum** one of the most important museums in Greece that presents the long history of the the sanctuary of Zeus, where the olimpic games began.

KATAKOLON (OLYMPIA) 45KM

seaside town, famous for the port where the ancient greek floked every four year to celebrate the sacred olympic games.

Katakolon is situated 34km from Ancient Olympia.

ACHAIA 115KM



It is part of the region of Western Greece and it's situated in the northwestern part of the Peloponnese peninsula. The capital is Patras which is the third largest city in Greece.

Another important city is EGIRA, an ancient polis with many archeological sites.

CASTLE CHLEMOUTSI 9KM
