### Junior Year- Checklist

#### August- December

- Login or Create a [GAFutures.org](http://GAFutures.org) account  
*\*Verify SSN is correct in CCSD system*
- Prepare for [ACT](#) and/or [SAT](#)
- Research careers using [GAFutures](#), [YouScience](#), [Naviance](#)
- Explore colleges by visiting campuses (virtual or in-person) and talking to admissions counselors  
*\*find out if there are specific courses that will be required at the schools on your list to help you with course registration senior year*
- Attend Financial Aid night to learn about FAFSA

#### January-February

- Register to take the [ACT](#) and/or [SAT](#)
- Gather information for registration for senior classes  
*\*Check DE deadlines, core teacher recommendations & electives*
- Review potential college essay prompts on [CommonApp](#)
- Research [scholarships](#)

#### March-June

- Register to take the [ACT](#) and/or [SAT](#)
- Create your [“Colleges I’m Thinking about”](#) list  
*\*In student Naviance account*
- Research [scholarships](#) that you will apply for senior year
- Submit contract to counselor if you plan to:
  - Graduate Early: December of Senior Year
  - Request Spring Minimum Day (Senior Year)
  - Request CVA/GAVS (up to 2 courses)
  - Participate in Dual Enrollment

#### Summer before Senior Year

- Retake [ACT](#) and/or [SAT](#)
- Create a calendar with college admission deadlines and [scholarship](#) deadlines
- Draft essays for college applications & scholarships
- Finalize [“Colleges I’m Applying To”](#) list

### Senior Year- Checklist

#### August- December

- Finalize [“Colleges I’m Applying To”](#) list
- Update calendar with admissions deadlines
- Begin applying to colleges on your list  
*\*Follow steps for Initial Transcript requests.*
- Write admissions essays
- Retake [ACT](#) and/or [SAT](#) (if necessary)  
*\*Student submits test scores to post-secondary destination.*
- Upload Resume to [Naviance](#)
- Complete Form for Counselor Letter of Recommendation
- Complete [FAFSA](#)- opens October 1

#### January- February

- Update calendar with [scholarship](#) deadlines
- Research and apply for scholarships
- Submit *Mid-year Transcript* (if necessary)

#### March-June

- Apply to college if you haven’t done so already!
- Apply for more [scholarships](#)
- May 1<sup>st</sup>- Deadline to accept college admissions offer  
*\*Submit deposits and confirm housing plans*
- Complete Senior Graduation Survey in [Naviance](#)
- Request *Final Transcript* (all colleges will require a final transcript to be sent)
- May - GRADUATION!!!

#### Summer before entering College

- Relax and enjoy time with family and friends.
- Register for Orientation and classes
- Have a great summer! 😊
