

HS Graduation Requirements

| Subject Area | # of Credits Needed |
|---|--|
| English | 4 |
| Math | 4 |
| Science | 4 |
| Social Studies | 3 |
| Health/Personal Fitness | 1 (0.5 Health/0.5 PE) |
| Career Tech and/or Fine Arts and/or World Language (WL)* (any combination will do) | 3 *2 credits of the <u>same</u> WL are required for college entrance |
| Electives | 4 |
| Total | 23 |

Promotion Requirements

Students can earn up to 8 credits per year, but you need specific credits to promote. (*32 potential credits over 4 years)

Must earn a total of 10 total credits to promote to 11th:

- Must pass 2 Required English
- Must pass 2 Required Math
- Must pass 2 Required Science
- Must pass 4 more classes

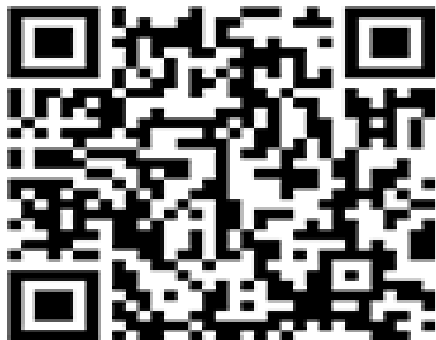
