What is a Professional Practice Model (PPM)?

- The driving force of nursing care. “It is a schematic description of a system, theory, or phenomenon that depicts how nurses practice, collaborate, coordinate, and develop professionally to provide the highest-quality care for people served by the organization (e.g. patients, families, communities).” Professional Practice Models illustrate “the alignment and integration of nursing practice with the mission, vision and values that nursing has adopted ¹




