Statement of Need: Stroke is the fifth leading cause of death and the leading cause of serious, long-term disability in the United States. There are also a significant number of patients who would be ideal candidates for mechanical thrombectomy who are not treated due to lack of access and/or inadequate decision-making methods/protocols. Both stroke incidence and mortality have decreased, and yet there continue to be disparities across the health systems in providing timely care. Healthcare providers must continue to learn about stroke care, barriers to care, and remain up-to-date with new guidelines.

Program Objectives: All Northwell Health CME activities are intended to improve patient care, safety and outcomes. At the conclusion of this conference participants should be able to:

- List and discuss strategies to overcome barriers to the implementation of stroke guidelines in the management of acute stroke.
- Summarize and apply key learning from case examples to the clinical management of stroke and secondary stroke.
- Recognize the role of evidence-based strategies in the evaluation and treatment of acute ischemic stroke.
- Identify the pharmacologic function, interactions and role of anticoagulant medications in the management of patients with stroke.
- Review the rationale for thrombectomy within a reasonable time frame and discuss outcomes based on the 6 hour window.
- Discuss the role of CT perfusion in stroke management.
- Explain the evidence behind the differences between the EMS stroke scales.
- Review guidelines for blood pressure management after stroke.
