NURSE SATISFACTION SURVEY OVERVIEW

Database: Phelps Hospital's nurses participate in the National Database of Nursing Quality Indicators (NDNQI[®]) RN Survey with the Practice Environment Scale and the Optional PES Magnet Module.

Measures: The survey categories we've selected to report include:

- Adequacy of Resources & Staffing
- Fundamentals of Quality Nursing Care
- Autonomy
- Professional Development Access

Benchmark: Phelps Hospital's performance is benchmarked against the NDNQI's All Hospital Mean.

Survey Date: The most recent RN Satisfaction survey was conducted in June 2019.

Nurse Participation: Our overall RN response rate for the most recent survey was 78%. Per NDNQI, Eligible RNs are full or part-time, regardless of job title, who spend at least 50% of their time in direct patient care, and have been employed a minimum of 3 months on the unit.
