
# June 18, 2020 Magnet<sup>®</sup> Minute:





What's all the buzz about Magnet? Magnet designation is the highest honor for nursing excellence awarded by the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC).. Research demonstrates that Magnet facilities have better patient outcomes, patient satisfaction, and nursing satisfaction, and lower RN turnover. Magnet-hospital designation is considered the "Gold Standard" for nursing practice in all settings, and by extension, the highest standards of quality and safety in patient care.

What exactly is Magnet<sup>®</sup> Recognition? "The Magnet Recognition Program is based on research that shows that creating a positive professional practice environment for nurses leads to improved outcomes – for staff and for patients. The standards for obtaining Magnet Recognition are based on the research and include requirements for visionary leadership, nursing structure, professional practice, quality improvement, nursing research and outcomes. Quality and safety standards are included in the requirements. The nurses' role in improving care is emphasized."

**Magnet®** requirements are very stringent. Magnet is the most prestigious credential a healthcare organization can achieve for nursing excellence and quality patient care.

#### Benefits to patients, staff, and the organization:

- Safety and high-quality care: decreased mortality rates, pressure ulcer rates, and falls
- Increased patient satisfaction
- Increased RN retention rates, decreased RN vacancy rates, reduced turnover
- Greater RN satisfaction than peers in other organizations
- Staff empowerment, culture of collaborative practice
- Advanced practice through clinical excellence, driving improvements
- Reduced injuries due to safer practice
- Reduction in marketing expenses, stronger bond ratings, and increased ability to establish endowments

**How many Magnet hospitals are there?** There are 520 Magnet <sup>®</sup>hospitals (about 8 % of United States' hospitals, nine countries outside the US and 6 Northwell hospitals ).

On site visit, the appraisers verify the information contained in our document and learn about our organization first-hand by visiting our patient care areas and speaking directly with staff (even though it will be virtual). This is the time to show your pride in the outcomes that we have achieved while working together!
