Staff Eye Protection Safety Precautions



Eye Protection is to be worn by all clinical and non-clinical healthcare providers in patient facing roles when a direct interaction with a patient is anticipated

Pictured above are the types of eye protection available: (Inventory dependent)

- Procedural/Surgical Masks with a built-in face shield (pictured at the bottom)
- Full Face shield (Pictured at the top left) to be worn with a procedural mask
- Goggles (pictured top right) to be worn with a procedural mask

Please note: N95 Masks are to be worn as indicated underneath the procedural/surgical mask.

Also Note: Safety glasses or personal eye glasses do not meet eye protection requirements

Where are they kept? Materials Management will stock the above in clinical areas such as clean supply rooms where PPE is normally stored. For Goggles/face shields speak with your unit manager or contact materials management.

Can they be reused? Yes-depending on the type of eye protection.

- **Procedural/Surgical Masks with face shield** cannot be reused and should be discarded once removed.
- **Full Face shield** can be cleaned and disinfected with an EPA approved disinfecting wipe (such as PDI Wipe) throughout the shift as needed and discard face shield once the shift is over.
- **Goggles** can be cleaned and disinfected with an EPA approved disinfecting wipe (such as PDI Wipe) and stored in a bag labeled with your name.
