Program Goal:

Clinical nurse “Skin Champions” will be able to accurately stage wounds, develop wound management plans, and act as resources to peers. They will be able to differentiate between Venous, Arterial, and Neuropathic wounds and categorize varying skin tears.

Outcomes:

1. PI Etiology: List the two etiologies for PI formation.
2. PI Prevention: Determine 5 nursing actions that can be implemented to prevent pressure injuries in a mock patient scenario.
3. PI Staging: Select the correct PI wound Stage for 5 patient cases presented via power point.
4. MASD: Will be able to differentiate between MASD and PI when shown 3 PP pictures of wounds. Will select 3 products that are appropriate for IAD and ITD care.
5. Demonstrate how to accurately measure 2 wound models and document on hospital PI intervention tool.
6. Will select one appropriate dressing for each of the 7 stages of pressure injuries.
7. Accurately identifies arterial, venous, and neuropathic wounds when presented with pictures and case scenarios.
8. Will select an appropriate dressing for an arterial, venous, neuropathic wounds.
9. Will properly categorize 4 different skin tears (photo's) and propose a correct dressing.
10. Verbalize when a wound culture is indicated and how to perform.
11. Demonstrate how to apply NPWT to wound models: Mushroom style, with undermining or a tunnel, making a bridge, and with irrigation.
12. List 2 patient criteria that would indicate using a Low Air Loss surface.
13. Demonstrate how to properly use the Air Tap Prevalon.
